BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

WHEREAS, Guam and the Marianas Islands have long revered the place of 1 women in society, women today continue to maintain positions of authority in 2 Guam society, in families, and in professional careers whether they are Chamorro 3 or of other ethnic backgrounds. Women on Guam maintaining a central role in 4 decision making is a traditional value that has carried on throughout the centuries 5 despite numerous changes and challenges such as the Christianization of 6 Chamorros in the latter part of the 17th century, and American hegemony 7 beginning in the 20th century. Women were able to maintain their authoritative 8 roles in the face of patriarchal values because of mothers' traditional custodial 9 roles. Women are responsible for child-rearing, finances, and family 10 responsibilities. 11

WHEREAS, the University of Guam Women and Gender Studies Program is an interdisciplinary minor and certificate program in the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences designed to provide students with a women-focused curriculum that fully incorporates the concept of gender and is responsive to the

issues, experiences, research, and discourse of women in Guam, throughout
Micronesia, and across cultures.

WHEREAS, the Women and Gender Studies Program's Regional Research Center covers a wide range of topics dealing with the processes, trends, and explanations of family, women, and gender in a changing society. The focus of the Research Center is to aid students in their understanding and development of major theories, issues, and research in the study of women. The Center is designed to provide students with the tools and abilities to assess, discuss, research, analyze, and write about change in gender relations throughout the Region.

WHEREAS, International Women's Day (March 8) is a global day 10 celebrating the social, economic, cultural and political achievements of women. 11 The day also marks a call to action for accelerating gender parity. No one 12 government, NGO, charity, corporation, academic institution, women's network or 13 media hub is solely responsible for International Women's Day. Many 14 organizations declare an annual IWD theme that supports their specific agenda or 15 cause, and some of these are adopted more widely with relevance than others. 16 International Women's Day is a collective day of global celebration and a call for 17 gender parity.
