3           **WHEREAS**, Marlene Mary McDonald Carbullido is the daughter of Charles

9           **WHEREAS**, Marlene is married to Paul Carbullido and together, they have

12           **WHEREAS**, after graduating from the Academy of Our Lady of Guam in  
13 1984, Marlene studied nursing at the University of Hawaii, Solano Community  
14 College, and the University of Guam and received an associate degree in Nursing in  
15 1989; and

16           **WHEREAS**, Marlene began her career as a Staff Nurse I – Triage, Emergent,  
17 and Urgent Care at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority in 1989. Marlene soon  
18 became a Community Health Nurse I at the Department of Public Health Social

1 Services, Bureau of Family Health and Nursing Services Central and Southern  
2 Villages, District Nursing, Homecare Nursing Southern Regional Health Center in  
3 1990. ; and

4 **WHEREAS**, throughout her career, she earned to higher education receiving  
5 a Bachelors of Science in Nursing at the University of Guam in 1999; a Masters of  
6 Science in Nursing at the University of Hawaii, Manoa; in addition to receiving a  
7 fellowship recipient from the World Health Organization in 1998; and

8 **WHEREAS**, in 1994, She became a Community Health Nurse II. From 1996  
9 to 1997 she served as the Community Health Nurse Supervisor I, where she led the  
10 Lihengta Infirmery, Post Typhoon Paka Shelter and the 1997 First Responder Team  
11 Leader for the Korean Airline Plane Crash. In 1997, Marlene served as Community  
12 Health Nurse Supervisor II; and

13 **WHEREAS**, Marlene has served many different roles during her career. She  
14 was the Administrator of the Emergency Medical Service Office; the Administrator  
15 of the Health Professional Licensing Office; EMS for Children Program Manager;  
16 Executive Director, Guam Board of Nurse Examiners; and Nursing Supervisor of  
17 the Guam Regional Medical City; and

18 **WHEREAS**, Marlene’s valuable insight and work has led her to contribute to  
19 various research and articles. She has published an article in the Guam Nursing  
20 Association’s Newsletter, Ramas Ubas, titled, “Thank you from a Fellow Nurse”.  
21 Additionally, Marlene published “How to Treat a Child with Special Needs in the  
22 ER” in the Journal of Emergency Nursing and “Improve Care of Children with  
23 Special Health Needs in ED Nursing in June 2002; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Marlene was nominated and awarded numerous awards  
25 throughout her career. In 2016, the Executive Officer Recognition Award was  
26 awarded to her by the National Council of State Boards of Nursing. That same year,  
27 Marlene was also given the MagPro Supervisor of the Year Award. Similarly in

1 2007, Marlene was awarded Supervisor of the Year Department-wide. During the  
2 years 1996, 2006, and 2007, she was named Outstanding Employee at the  
3 Department of Public Health and Social Services. Marlene also received the  
4 Community Health Award in 2006 from the Guam Nurses Association; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Marlene has served an illustrious career in Nursing and  
6 contributed immensely to the health industry on Guam; now, therefore be it
