4           **WHEREAS**, the Marianas Travelers Lodge #49, Agana Guam under the Most  
5 Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge F & A.M, State of Washington and Jurisdiction has  
6 been on Guam since July 1965; and

7           **WHEREAS**, Grand Master Lester L. Dickson is the Grand Master of Masons Most  
8 Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge F & A. M. State of Washington and Jurisdiction. On  
9 Guam lodge members continue to be instrumental in preserving the lodge's mission to  
10 serve for all. The annual session will take place April 7-13, 2019 and members will gather  
11 to commemorate the accomplishments of the lodge and remember the traditions that have  
12 kept the lodge strong in their commitment: Listings of some of the accomplishments of  
13 their Lodge; and
