WHEREAS, Dr. Kasperbauer worked at the University of Guam (UOG) as a Professor of Sociology, Chair of the Department of Sociology and Division of Social Science; Dean of the College of Education (1968-1974), and Assistant Vice President (1974-1977); and in 1993, he was bestowed with the honor of Professor Emeritus of Sociology; and

WHEREAS, as Dean of the College of Education, Dr. Kasperbauer implemented a curriculum and a two (2)-fold teacher training support program that helped to develop the island's educational system that trained local teachers, while providing the residents of Guam with a sustainable career on the island. Prior to this, the Government of Guam would recruit teachers from the United States mainland which was a necessary, but costly approach; and a teacher training scholarship program for local students seeking to become teachers was created with the hope that this would help alleviate the shortage of teachers; and

WHEREAS, after retiring from UOG, Dr. Kasperbauer continued his advocacy for improved education in a new role as legislator of 1 Liheslaturan Guåhan where he served for five (5) terms as a Senator and was also a former Vice Speaker.
