BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I MINA TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

**WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2020, the University of Guam Endowment Foundation and School of Education presented and honored Dr. Lawrence F. Kasperbauer with the Lifetime Achievement Award; and

**WHEREAS**, receiving his Ph.D. in Rural Sociology from Iowa State University in 1965, Dr. Lawrence F. Kasperbauer continued his work in research and education, producing research on demographic and sociological communities on Guam; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Kasperbauer worked at the University of Guam (UOG) as a Professor of Sociology, Chair of the Department of Sociology and Division of Social Science; Dean of the College of Education (1968-1974), and Assistant Vice President (1974-1977); and in 1993, he was bestowed with the honor of Professor Emeritus of Sociology; and

**WHEREAS**, as Dean of the College of Education, Dr. Kasperbauer implemented a curriculum and a two (2)-fold teacher training support program that helped to develop the island's educational system that trained local teachers, while providing the residents of Guam with a sustainable career on the island. Prior to this, the Government of Guam would recruit teachers from the United States mainland which was a necessary, but costly approach; and a teacher training scholarship program for local students seeking to become teachers was created with the hope that this would help alleviate the shortage of teachers; and

**WHEREAS**, after retiring from UOG, Dr. Kasperbauer continued his advocacy for improved education in a new role as legislator of I Liheslaturan Guåhan where he served for five (5) terms as a Senator and was also a former Vice Speaker. He chaired the Legislative Committee on Education, and Senator Kasperbauer's contributions to education and the community include sponsorship of over one hundred (100) laws that mandated the building and renovations of schools, made learning safer, expanded higher educational opportunities at UOG and GCC, provided financial assistance and resources for island educators and nurses, and ensured the public's safety; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Kasperbauer has served as Chairman of the Guam Board of Education; and he is currently the President of the Society of Emeritus Professors and Retired Scholarship, and he was recognized by the Guam Chapter of the Phi Delta Kappa and inducted into the Guam Educator's Hall of Fame in 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Kasperbauer has taken volunteer leadership roles over the years in many community services and civic programs; and he had served as Chairman of the Territorial Board of Education, Member of the *Dededo* Municipal Planning Council, President of the *Agaña Heights* PTA, President of the Guam Girl Scouts Board of Directors, Commissioner of the Guam Youth Football League, President of the Guam Running Club, and President of the *Agaña Heights* Holy Name Society; and

**WHEREAS**, Dr. Kasperbauer is married to Carmen Kasperbauer, and they have five (5) children: Kevin, Karen, Brian, Steven, and Teresa; now therefore, be it:


