RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES 1 BE IT OF I 2 MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:

3 WHEREAS, for years, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority's (GMHA) efforts to "rebase" (set a new base level) for Medicare reimbursement rates approved 4 by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) have been an on-going 5 challenge. CMS had continuously denied efforts, citing GMHA's inability to support 6 7 its request; and

8 WHEREAS, the rebasing process evaluates how average costs have changed from the rate base year to the present date, while also accounting for inflation. Rebasing 9 10 would allow GMHA to be reimbursed for treating patients under Medicare, at a rate that reflects the present cost of medical care; and 11

1 WHEREAS, the continuous denial by CMS to adjust GMHA patient rates 2 resulted in reimbursement based on averages from 1998, resulting in years of 3 underfunding GMHA compensation for patient care; and

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WHEREAS, convincing CMS to increase the Medicare base rate has been a longstanding priority and goal for many past Board of Trustees members, former 5 Administrators, Chief Financial Officers, management and staff of GMHA; and 6

WHEREAS, Chief Financial Officer (CFO) Benita Mangloña of GMHA since 7 2015 took the lead in GMHA's decade-long effort to achieve "rebased" patient rates by 8 9 working closely with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS); and

10 WHEREAS, on January 12, 2019 CMS finally approved the request for a updated base rate for Medicare patient reimbursements and agreed to make the higher 11 base rate effective on October 1, 2013, through the end of fiscal year 2016. GMHA rates 12 will now be equal to that of other similarly sized U.S. hospitals; and 13

WHEREAS, the new base rate increased GMHA discharge rates from \$5,100 to 14 \$9,500 per discharge, for fiscal years 2014 through 2016. GMHA has received \$6.3 15 million dollars in back payments for the higher rate thus far and expects to receive at 16 17 least \$4 million more for fiscal years 2017 and 2018; and

18 WHEREAS, the decision by CMS to "rebase" the patient care rates for the Guam 19 Memorial Hospital Authority is a substantial victory and GMHA's relentless dedication to this daunting task will ensure that moving forward, millions of dollars in much 20 21 needed revenue will be safeguarded for Guam's only public civilian hospital.
