WHEREAS, Mrs. Kwek Santos attended school at Saint Anthony Catholic School and graduated from the Academy of Our Lady of Guam in 1989 before receiving her bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Washington State University in 1993 and her MBA from the University of Phoenix in 2010. Mrs. Kwek Santos was a Certified Public Accountant under the Guam Board of Accountancy, an Accredited Investment Fiduciary from the Center for Fiduciary Studies, and a Certified QuickBooks Pro Advisor; and

8 WHEREAS, Mrs. Kwek Santos began her career working as a Senior Auditor 9 with Deloitte and Touche LLP in June 1993; in October 1997, she joined her family's 10 business and served as the Controller of Kwek Enterprises, Inc.; and in March 2001, 11 she returned to work at Deloitte as a Manager in an Advisory position; and

12 WHEREAS, in December 2007, Carmen Kwek Santos accepted the position of 13 Vice President of Business and Finance at the Guam Community College (GCC), which was later expanded to the position of Vice President of Finance and Administration, 14 15 with charge over the GCC Business Office, Environmental Health and Safety, Financial 16 Aid, Human Resources, Materials Management, and Management Information System, 17 which are all the departments that maintain the backbone upon which GCC delivers the highest quality, student-centered education and job training for Guam and the 18 19 Micronesia/Pacific region; and

WHEREAS, the strong financial position that GCC has maintained for the past nineteen (19) years has been a critical catalyst to the modernization and expansion of the GCC campus, which has provided modern classrooms, improved teaching tools, and access to technology that has allowed its students to transition seamlessly from classroom to careers; and WHEREAS, in addition, under the management of Mrs. Carmen Kwek Santos,
 GCC became the first government of Guam agency to operate a fully cloud-based MIS
 system, thereby improving the speed of service, and having an expanded capacity and
 better reliability; and

5 WHEREAS, along with her invaluable contributions to the Guam Community 6 College, Mrs. Kwek Santos had volunteered her time and knowledge serving as the 7 President of Habitat for Humanity Guam, and at the Saint Anthony Catholic School 8 where she served as the Board Chairperson; and she had also held memberships in the 9 American Institute of Certified Public Accountants; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Carmen Kwek Santos passed away on May 13, 2020; and she is survived by her husband Michael Santos, their two (2) daughters, Meagan and Samantha, her parents Johnnie Kwek and Helen Leung Kwek, her brother Melvyn Kwek, her sister Carolyne Kwek Calixterio, her Guam Community College family, and the many individuals whose lives she had touched and helped through her service with Habitat for Humanity Guam and Saint Anthony Catholic School; now therefore, be it
