1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF**
2 *I MINA'TRENTAI SINGKO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:*

3 **WHEREAS**, Sergeant First Class (SFC) Jesse Lujan was born and raised on
4 Guam. He is originally from the village of Inarajan and is a 2003 graduate of Southern
5 High School located in Santa Rita, Guam. He is married to his high school sweetheart,
6 Valerie Pablo Lujan and they have four (4) beautiful children; and

7 **WHEREAS**, SFC Lujan comes from a long tradition of service in the United
8 States military. In his family, his uncles and grandfather have proudly served in the
9 Army and the Navy. The service of his relatives and the motivation to achieve his
10 dreams were the catalyst in which he decided to enlist in the Army on April 1, 2004;
11 and

12 **WHEREAS**, SFC Lujan has served our nation with distinction. He has deployed
13 to Afghanistan twice and once in Iraq. His duty assignments include locations in South

1 Korea, Germany and Hawaii. He has been able to live a fulfilling life with his family
2 and has the opportunity to return to Guam to further serve our island and nation; and

3 **WHEREAS**, he has received numerous accolades and awards for his service in
4 the military. His outstanding work ethic and dedication has garnered great respect and
5 recognition from his colleagues and leadership. He has successfully completed
6 numerous leadership courses in the Army in the field of combat, lifesaving, battle staff,
7 human resources and recruitment; and

8 **WHEREAS**, a further indication of his ability to perform outstandingly can be
9 further attested to his current role as a Recruiter at the *Hagåtña* Recruiting Station,
10 Guam Company, Portland Battalion, where he also enlisted into the Army years ago.
11 SFC Lujan has helped many men and women on Guam and around our neighboring
12 islands enlist into the Army. SFC Lujan goes above and beyond to help guide aspiring
13 service members. He truly believes in offering holistic support to those who want to
14 dedicate themselves to a life in service because it takes a lot of courage and
