REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Resolution No. 107-34 (COR) - "RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING A "WHEELS TO WORK" PROGRAM TO PROVIDE GUAM REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY BUS PASSES TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE UNEMPLOYED AND ARE ACTIVELY SEEKING WORK, SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS, PAID BY VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS FROM SENATORIAL OFFICE BUDGETS, AND TO DIRECT THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF I LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN TO ESTABLISH POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR THE PROGRAM," was introduced by Senator Michael F.Q. II. TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Michael F.Q. San Nicolas, Chairman, Committee on General Government Operations and Federal, Foreign, and Regional Affairs (the "Committee") and Author of Resolution No. 107-34 (COR) ("the Resolution"), convened the hearing for the Resolution. The Author of the Resolution, Senator San Nicolas provided the following opening statements:

"Basically, what Resolution 107 will do is it will have the Executive Director set up a program by which any senator on a voluntary basis if they have the resources available can go ahead and purchase bus passes in order for unemployed individuals to avail of them in order to find work. This will allow for us to encourage frugality within our offices if we are able to manage that, and if we are, then to be able to put it towards this program. It's one of those things where it would be something good to start, see how it works, and if it works out well, I'm sure we will get more support behind it, and it's one of those measures that would be more dependent upon the individual senator having the ability to contribute. So we wouldn't be adding a new social program onto the liabilities of the general fund, this will be out of existing resources that are already committed to *I Liheslatura*, and funded entirely by office budgets that are able to render the savings necessary to pay for the passes.

Senator San Nicolas recognized that there was no one signed up to testify and shared that he will continue to receive testimony on the measure. Senator San Nicolas then concluded the hearing for the Resolution.

III. FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

The Author of the Resolution, Senator Michael F.Q. BE IT RESOLVED BY I LIHESLATURAN GUÂHAN:

WHEREAS, many of Guam's neediest individuals lack adequate transportation to use their time and resources in the most effective manner to improve the quality of lives of themselves and their families; and

WHEREAS, in an average quarter, it is likely that dozens to hundreds of people do not actively seek work because they lack transportation while they are not working; and

WHEREAS, providing transportation to those who require it to seek full or part-time employment can serve as an important investment in Guam's workforce by helping individuals who are able to seek work; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Regional Transit Authority's (GRTA) proposed updated regular fare monthly bus passes cost seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per month and three (3) months would cost nine hundred dollars (\$900.00) per individual; and

WHEREAS, providing as many as eighty (80) individuals three (3) months'
worth of passes during a year would cost a *proposed* (\$18,000.00); now therefore
be it

RESOLVED, that *I Mina'Trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of the people of Guam, establish a "Wheels to Work" program to provide GRTA bus passes to individuals who are unemployed and are actively seeking work, subject to availability of funds, paid by voluntary contributions from senatorial office budgets; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the "Wheels to Work" program *shall* provide up to three (3) monthly bus passes per year, subject to voluntary participation of individual senatorial offices and further subject to the availability of funds, to each individual who submits an application to the office of the Executive Director of *I Mina'trentai Kuåttro Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* and qualifies as an unemployed individual who is actively seeking work, on a first come, first served basis; and be it further
