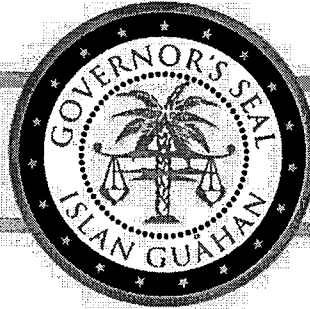



Good afternoon Chairman Joe San Agustin, honorable members of the Committee on General Government Operations, Appropriations, Housing, & Office of Finance and Budget. I come here today to support the nomination of Frank Ishizaki to serve as a member of the GHURA Board of Commissioners. I was quite excited when I learned of Governor Lou Leon Guerrero appointing Frank to serve on GHURA's "Dream Team". Mr. Ishizaki is someone I've come to know personally over the past few years, and someone I consider a very good friend and a mentor. Frank truly is the perfect fit for a governing board that has gone through federal scrutiny in recent years. As we all know, GHURA is 100% federally funded, but unlike most GovGuam agencies who depend on federal funds, our operation is governed almost entirely by federal statutes and guidelines.

Just last week HUD officials (to include HUD's attorney) came out and put GHURA's Board and Executive Management through extensive training. The training included matters involving Conflict of Interest (in Procurement, Public Housing & Section 8), Litigation Reporting Requirements, Hatch Act, as well as other matters. Surprisingly, the Hatch Act (which ensures federal employees are free from partisan political influence or coercion) applies to all GHURA personnel, and yes GHURA's Board of Commissioners as well. It doesn't matter that we are not federal employees. In fact, HUD has made it very clear that violations of the Hatch Act or conflicts of interest provision may result in penalties such as loss of federal funding, removal from our respective positions, or in certain cases that most of us are now familiar with...prosecution.

I am confident that Frank Ishizaki, being a retired federal employee with the FBI, could have conducted the training that HUD did last week. As he was the gentleman that I spoke to often for guidance when it seemed I didn't have too many republican friends left. Mr. Ishizaki was always there for me. In fact, if Frank was on the previous Board, perhaps the outcomes may have been different.

But GHURA is in great hands now under the leadership of Board Chairman Sabino Flores. And Frank Ishizaki will bring much more professional diversity to

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

The public hearing was called-to-order at **2:00PM**.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you sir, it is now 2:09, we will now proceed to Mr. Ishizaki, Senators Ishizaki, if you can please come forward and also Mr. Topasna, I will start first with the Chief, Senator former FBI agent current instructor and former police officer, like myself. Sir, Senator if you please sir.

Frankie T. Ishizaki: Thank you, Mr. Chair and I am honored to sit before you and Senator Biscoe Lee, thank you for being here. I appreciate the governor's appointment for nominating me to be a border commissioner member and look forward to helping. I have got a long civic history and I love Guam and I think that that most important piece I recall is when I was in junior high, we had this horrendous typhoon, it was typhoon Karen and I think that is when my recollections when Ghura stood up and built a new village and Yona, Sinajana, and Agana Heights and that was just to replace the homes that were lost because Guam was just devastated and then we had Section 8 housing built all over the place so Ghura has been doing a great job for our community and I look forward to participating and helping in every way I can.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you Chief, Senator Mr. Topasna.

Ray Topasna: Thank you, Mr. Chair, Senator Biscoe Lee, good afternoon for the record my name is Ray Topasna, and I am the executive director at Ghura. I come here today to support the nomination of Frankie Ishizaki to see as a member of the Ghura Board of Commissioners.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you, Mr. Topasna, also I like to recognize that we also have testimony or written testimony from Joseph Cameron, one of the members and Senator Lee do you have any questions for the Senator?

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: *Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* Mr. Chair and again I want to thank our Governor for an excellent nomination a very happy Senator that you have taken up this charge and have agreed to assist us in this role. I do just want to note for the record for those who might not know Senator Ishizaki that he has served the people of Guam, and the Government of Guam, at the University of Guam, at Department of Corrections, at the Guam Police Department, at Homeland Security, here in the Guam legislature. The list goes on and on and on and he's also a contributor many people an hear his words and his thoughts. He provides opinion editorials and you know he calls us up every once in a while, and says hey what the heck are you guys doing over there? You know and it's a really, it's great to be able to have a sounding board in somebody who has sat in these chairs who knows the role of the legislature but also has a lot of other expertise and knowledge to bring to the table so I'm so glad that you have agreed to the governor's appointment, I will ask you the same questions that I posed to Mr. Jugo just a few moments ago in terms of you know I've been looking through your packet. I know that you own and operate your own business so in terms of conflicts of interest, Senator do you believe that at any point you may across a conflict and how would you deal with that?"

Frank T. Ishizaki: Thank you Senator, I'm not aware of any conflicts that I currently have or for conflicts in the future but I'm aware of the practices in general about declaring conflicts so if there is a conflict, I will declare it and I'll do everything I can to stay out of something.

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: Excellent and we also know that you have various roles in our community so we just want to make sure that you will be able to dedicated the time to in preparation for the board meeting and attending the board meetings many times we have many of our boards and commissions, some issues with quorum so we just want to make sure that who the individuals that we are confirming to these positions are able to attend and able to really sink their teeth in and dive down into these issues to help our agencies so I just wanted to see if I could get a verbal commitment from you in terms of the time that is required to sit on this board and actively participate.

Frank T. Ishizaki: I appreciate that questions Senator and it's a question of my wife raises but I promise to do the best I can and to participate barring any unforeseen ball issues and problems but thank you.

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: *Si Yu'os Ma'åse'* to you and to your wife because we all know that it's a family affair and I'm really glad that Mr. Topasna is here as well because he has experienced a lot of things over the last few years in terms of things that we envision and our mission and our vision for Ghura and certain times when that has kind of been derailed by certain members of the board in the past and so I just wanted to ask you, I know that I can say that you certainly have my support and I'll encourage my colleagues to support you as well but do you have any comments in terms of the you can certainly expect oversight from us but we also want you to stand up and be a vocal advocate for the people of Guam in your position as a board member and so I just wanted to give you an opportunity to kind of expand and explain maybe based on your prior experience how sometimes you may have been the only person in the room standing up and just saying that maybe something doesn't smell right maybe there's something else that we should take a look at so I just kind of wanted to give you an opportunity to perhaps give the committee an example of where you may have stood up for something that you believed was wrong something you know stood up in opposition to something that you believed was wrong.

Frank T. Ishizaki: Well thank you for that questions. You know I believe this Senators that when we serve our people, we should do everything we can to do good for our community because I think our people are counting on I and so I believe in accountability and I believe in transparency and if people are not meeting that those tasks was an expectations then they should be we should hold their feet to the fire and so I hope nobody ever has to hold my feet to the fire because I would do my part to do good for our people.

Senator Régine Biscoe Lee: And thank you very much sir for coming on the record and again for accepting the governor's nomination. I think it's an extremely important position and we need credible people who are going to have bring that accountability bring that transparency and that integrity to the job and so we thank you, thanks very much for Mr. Topasna for being here and other members of Ghura so we want to thank you in advance for your service and I look forward to voting favorable on your nominee, *Si Yu'os Ma'åsi*, thank you, Mr. Chair.

Chairman Joe S. San Agustin: Thank you, thank you Senator Lee and you know Chief, Senator, I've only I always asked only three questions of any agency that I oversee is where you at, where you want to go and how can I help you and being that Mr. Topasna said on his testimony they told him, be

careful what you wish for, too much talent brings too much oversight. I did you're joining, you're going to e joining the Dream Team, your part of the Dream Team and I look forward to working very closely with all of you and whenever you need help just ask and if you believe you want me to step in and do an oversight hearing on your agency, I know you're not going to want it chief because I'm going to be calling and I'm be saying really chief and he's going to say just bring him in, I send a knob, I have no problem that one we both was that wore the same uniform I used to wear the blue suitors like yourself before you went to the FBI and with your, you know, your background sir, I look forward to it like I asked you up at UOG really?
