Legislative Bill No. 268-35 is an act to add a new § 1039 to Chapter 10, Title 1 of the Guam Code Annotated. The proposed legislation intends to recognize *CHamorus* and other members of our community that have advocated for the peoples of *Guahån* by officially declaring the second (2nd) day in September of each year as *Ha'anen I Manmanachu Siha Put I Taotao Tano'*. Furthermore, *I Kumision I Fino' CHamoru yan I Fina'na'guen I Historia yan I Lina'la' Taotao Tano'* (the Commission on CHamoru Language and the Teaching of the History and Culture of the Indigenous People of Guam) shall plan and make appropriate arrangements for the observance of this day and may delegate such planning to any other appropriate entity.

The proposed amendment is administrative in nature and would not fiscally impact the appropriations of FY 2020.
