Footnote 1/: The overall intent of the proposed Bill is to appropriate \$400,000 from the unappropriated, unallocated fund balance of the Fiscal Year 2019 Tourist Attraction Fund (TAF) to the Guam Visitors Bureau (GVB) for deposit into the Guam FESTPAC & Folklife Festival Trust Account to fund Guam's participation in the 2020 FESTPAC. The Bill also proposes to appropriate \$100K annually from the TAF to the Guam FESTPAC & Folklife Festival Trust Account to fund future FESTPACs. Based on the attached Independent Auditor's Report on the TAF for the year ending September 30, 2018, the TAF has a negative fund balance of \$173,865. Additionally, per the FY 2019 Special Revenue Fund Tracking Report (Month ending April 30, 2019) the TAF is tracking to fall short by \$676,309. As such, there is no additional TAF revenues to support Bill 158-35 or any new legislation introduced to be funded by the TAF. Should all TAF appropriations in P.L. 34-116 be expended, the TAF fund balance at the end of FY 2019 will be approximately negative \$850K. Per communications with GVB, Bill No. 158-35 (COR) is currently under review with their Board of Directors.
