#### Comments on Bill No. 178-35 (LS)

This proposed legislation seeks to appropriate \$1,200,000 from the Fiscal Year 2017 Audited Available Fund Balance of the Healthy Futures Fund (HFF) to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for *I Guma' Mina'āse* Foster Care Facility operations. The amount shall be used by the government of Guam to fund personnel, equipment, supplies, and contractual services required for the health and safety of children at the foster care facility. As mentioned in Section 1 of the bill, the fund source was identified through the Fiscal Year 2017 auditor's report which notes \$6.9 million as the HFF Fund Balance ending September 30, 2017 (and \$10,194,826 fund balance ending September 30, 2018).

The Bureau recognizes the FY 2018 Audit cites an available fund balance of \$10.1M in the HFF. Taking into account the passage of a number of Public Laws which have used this fund source and the current FY2019 tracking of the HFF which is anticipated to fall short by -\$1M, the Government of Guam is currently recognizing the available balance of the HFF at \$4M.

The public laws that been passed since the close of FY 2018 that appropriate funds from the HFF in addition to funds appropriated via P.L. 34-116 are:

- P.L. 34-141 Appropriated \$3,500,000 from the FY 2018 HFF fund balance to the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) for Medicaid match in FY 2019.
- P.L. 34-147 Appropriated \$300,000 from the HFF to DPHSS for the Child Protective Services Division and Program
- P.L. 34-148 Appropriated \$700,000 from the HFF to DPHSS for Medicaid match in FY 2019.
- P.L. 35-027 Appropriated \$150,000 from the HFF fund balance to the Department of Administration for the Guam Autism Center.
- Total HFF Appropriations \$4,650,0000

Considering that all adopted HFF appropriations were fully appropriated per P.L. 34-116 (FY 2019 Budget Act), the proposed bill does not factor in the current tracking of Special Revenue Fund Report for FY 2019. As of the month ending June 30, 2019, the HFF is projecting overall collections of \$40,048,284 in FY 2019, which is -\$1,371,383 less of P.L. 34-116's adopted level of \$41,419,667.

Taking into consideration the public laws mentioned above and the projected revenue shortfall in the HFF, the balance available for appropriation is \$4,173,443. The Bureau notes that the proposed bill's intent to appropriate \$1.2M from the HFF would now result in a total fund balance of \$2,973,443, and with the proposed \$6.0M appropriation under Bill 179-35 (LS), the total fund balance would result in a negative balance or an over-appropriation from the HFF of -\$3,026,557. Please note that the HFF fund balance is not "cash" in the bank but an accounting of the inflows and outflows from this fund. Caution should be taken in the continued use of available fund balances as sources of funds, especially if the amount to be sourced is significant.
