The Bureau requests that Bill No. 212-35 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 212-35 (LS) is an act to add §6110(d) to Chapter 6, Title 3 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to the submission of a drug test by those seeking an elected public office.

The Legislation, if passed, would require all candidates seeking an elected public office, board or commission to submit a drug test containing the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration's guideline checklist of illicit drugs. The bill would also require the individual seeking the elected position to bear the cost of the drug test.

The intent of the proposed measure is administrative in nature and, as such, poses no fiscal impact on any funds of the Government of Guam.
