Comments for Legislative Bill No. 290-35 (COR):

This proposed bill seeks to appropriate Thirty-Five Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$35,630) from the unappropriated fund balance of the Manpower Development Fund (MDF) as of the yearend of FY 2019. Such appropriation is for the purpose of funding local manpower training program and other operational requirements as authorized pursuant to § 7120 of Article 1, Chapter 7, Title 22, Guam Code Annotated. Although this appropriation is directed to the Department of Labor (DOL), this appropriation would also be distributed to both DOL and the Guam Community College (GCC) per the above cited legislation. Of the amount appropriated, thirty percent is to be appropriated to the Department of Labor (DOL) and the remaining balance of 70% is to the GCC.

Per the unaudited financial statements prepared by the Department of Administration (DOA) as of February 2020, the yearend FY 2019 Fund Balance of the Manpower Development Fund is estimated at \$36,502. Therefore, the MDF fund balance at yearend FY 2019 is sufficient to cover the appropriation in this Act.

However, such appropriation would increase the total FY 2020 appropriation as the result of the possible passage of this Bill in FY 2020 and posted against the available fund balance as of 2019, not against new MDF FY 2020 revenues. The fiscal impact is a possible potential deficit to the MDF fund in FY 2020 should the adopted revenues are not met. Such possibility would need to be covered by revenues of the General fund.
