1/: The proposed legislation intends to transfer the administrative jurisdiction of 773,792± square meters contained in Lot 7147, municipality of Yigo, to the Department of Agriculture (DOAg) for the purpose of placing such lot in the Guam Forestry and Legacy Act of 2012 land inventory. Lot 7147 was cited in the 1999 Department and Recreation Parks and Conservation Lands Master Plan as an ideal location for the conservation and reforestation efforts of the DOAg Forestry Division. The proposed transfer of Lot 7147 would mean the DOAg Forestry Division, and its available resources, will now be responsible for removing invasive species and restoring native plant species indigenous to the limestone forest of the Northern portion of the island. Absent feedback from the DOAg, the Bureau is unable to determine if the DOAg's current local and federal resources are sufficient to cover an additional 191.2 acres of conservation area or if they will need additional resources.
