Bureau of Budget & Management Research Comments on Bill No. <u>295-35 (COR)</u>

The proposed legislation intends to amend §77114 of Chapter 77, Title 21 Guam Code Annotated (GCA) by: 1) excluding the Public Recreation Services Fund (PRSF) from the Governor's transfer authority; and 2) eliminating the requirement for expenditures from the PRSF to be appropriated legislatively. It should be noted that P.L. 35-36 appropriates \$112,707 from the PRSF to the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) for the purposes outlined in §77114, Chapter 77, Title 21 GCA.

Section 8 of Chapter 13, Part 2, P.L. 35-36 authorizes the governor to transfer up to fifteen percent (15%) between Fiscal Year 2020 General Fund Executive Branch appropriations. The PRSF is established separate and apart from the General Fund. As such, the PRSF is already restricted from the Governor's transfer authority.

By eliminating the requirement for the Legislature to appropriate funds from the PRSF, the DPR would instead be able to appropriate funds upon receipt. Section 11(m) of Chapter 13, Part 2, P.L. 35-36 authorizes the DPR to expend up to the level of revenues collected from the PRSF in FY 2020, meaning a funding mechanism to access collections from the PRSF in excess of its adopted level in P.L. 35-36 already exists. As such, the Bureau notes this provision in the proposed legislation may not be necessary.
