1/: The subject legislation directs the GEDA to procure a new financial management system and transaction processing system for use by the Government of Guam. The GEDA may secure the services of a third-party consultant (through competitive bid) to serve as a Program Management Office tasked with, but not limited to, the following: research current and future government needs, provide guidance and recommendations based on industry practices, etc. The Bill appropriates two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) from the FY2019 Unappropriated General Fund balance for the aforementioned purpose. However, it should be noted that, per the FY2019 Government of Guam Single Audit, the FY2019 GF surplus of \$35.6M was applied towards the GF deficit of \$83.4M thereby bringing down the deficit at the end of FY2019 to \$47.8M. As such, the fund source identified in the Bill is not available for appropriation.
