'What you did to my boy wasn't nice," John Tedtaotao, Alvarez's stepfather, said from the witness stand as he held back tears. "You took away my boy's life. ... I just want to let you know that looking at you and facing you is the final (thing for me)."

The mother of Alvarez's child, Jessica Diaz, also addressed Simiron during the hearing

"It's like a nightmare that will never go away," Diaz said. "What happened to Gil, the father of my child, is (something we're) going to live with forever. Gil was a very good person. He loved to be around people. He was very helpful and had a kind, loving heart, and he loved his two daughters. ... Do you

Simiron will be eligible for parole after he serves 20 years of his sentence.

"I'd like to recognize the victim's family in this case for their strength and presence at each phase of the case," said Assistant Attorney General Sean Brown. "We are pleased that the court agreed with our position on sentencing

in guaranteeing that the defendant will serve 20 years before even becoming eligible for parole. I hope this sentence will help ease the pain of the victim's family as well as bring some closure to the lives of the people that suffered the loss of their loved one."

In February 2017, Alvarez was found unconscious and lying face-down on the ground on President's Lane near the University of Guam in Mangilao.

Simiron and his co-defendant, Mallo Mango Sally, had asked Alvarez for a ride and while in the pickup plotted to beat him up and steal his truck.

Sally pleaded guilty and sentenced to serve 15 years in prison for his part in the killing.

Brown requested restitution in the amount of \$116,000 for the victim's family. A hearing on that issue will be held at a later date.

beings," the FSM government stated. The FSM government expressed hope that the incident will not paint all FSM migrants who have made Guam home with the same broad brush.

'The government of the FSM hopes that the people and government of

Guam will not condemn the people and government of the FSM for the undesirable and unlawful actions of a few, in light of the continuing positive and productive community contributions of the vast majority of FSM citizens living and working in Guam."

The FSM government promotes peace, the statement said, adding that

"the behavior of a citizen of the FSM has negatively impacted one or more lives." Through the FSM Consulate Office on Guam, and working with partners here, the FSM will develop and implement programs "that will attempt to ensure that incidents of this sort don't occur," the FSM government stated.

"The government and people of the FSM express their sincerest apologies to those affected by this unfortunate incident."

The FSM government encouraged its citizens on Guam "to collectively strive to improve their lives and the lives of those around them." (Daily Post Staff)

GRMC specialty clinics, outpatient departments and inpatient units will continue to operate.

GRMC Vice President of Corporate Affairs Eric Plinske declined to provide further comment on the restructuring effort.

Boardroom power struggle

Over the past year, GRMC has been caught up in a boardroom power struggle over ownership of PSI Healthcare Development Services, a Philippine corporation that owns The Medical City in Metro Manila and its health care network, which includes GRMC.

The ownership dispute pits 84-year-old Dr. Alfredo Bengzon, a former secretary of the Philippine Department of Health during the Corazon Aquino presidency, against his nephew, Jose "Eckie" Gonzales.

Philippine media last year reported that Gonzales and the Singapore-based Clermont Group ousted Bengzon as president and CEO of The Medical City after gaining control of 54% of PSI's stock.

A March 20 release issued by The Medical City stated that shareholders started to question Bengzon's management of the company, after learning that \$411 million had been spent on opening and maintaining GRMC "far in excess of the original \$220 million planned for the Guam hospital," according to the release.

Bengzon's daughter-in-law, Margaret Bengzon, was ousted as GRMC chief executive officer in November 2018. She sued for reinstatement. But on March 27, Judge Elyze Iriarte of the Superior Court of Guam dismissed her lawsuit, ruling that Bengzon "lacked standing" to file suit on Guam.

US sending more troops to the Middle East

Acting U.S. Defense Secretary Patrick Shanahan announced on Monday the deployment of about 1,000 more troops to the Middle East for what he said were defensive purposes, citing concerns about a threat from Iran.

Fears of a confrontation between Iran and the United States have mounted since last Thursday when two oil tankers were attacked, which Washington has blamed on Tehran, more than a year after President Donald Trump said Washington was withdrawing from a 2015 nuclear deal.

The recent Iranian attacks validate the reliable, credible intelligence we have received on hostile behavior by Iranian forces and their proxy groups that threaten United States personnel and interests across the region," Shanahan said in a statement.

The new U.S. deployment to the Middle East is in addition to a 1,500troop increase announced last month in response to tanker attacks in May. Washington previously tightened sanctions, ordering all countries and companies to halt imports of Iranian oil or be banished from the global financial system.

Iran said on Monday it would soon breach limits on how much enriched uranium it can stockpile under the deal, which a White House National

Security Council spokesman said amounted to "nuclear blackmail."

The 2015 accord, which Iran and the other signatories have maintained following Trump's decision, caps Iran's stock of low-enriched uranium at 661 pounds enriched to 3.67%.

But Iran's Atomic Energy Organization spokesman Behrouz Kamalvandi said on Monday: "We have quadrupled the rate of enrichment (of uranium) and even increased it more recently, so that in 10 days it will bypass the (660-pound) limit."

"Iran's reserves are every day increasing at a more rapid rate," he told state TV, adding that "the move will be reversed once other parties fulfill their commitments."

The move further undermines the nuclear pact also signed by Russia, Britain, Germany, China and the European Union, but Iranian President Hassan Rouhani said the collapse of the deal would not be in the interests of the region or the world.

The nuclear deal seeks to head off any pathway to an Iranian nuclear bomb in return for the removal of most international sanctions.

Britain said if Iran breached agreed limits, London would look at "all options." Israel, Iran's arch foe, urged world powers to step up sanctions against Tehran swiftly should it

exceed the enriched uranium limit.

European Union foreign policy chief Federica Mogherini said, however, the EU would only react to any breach if the International Atomic Energy Agency formally identified one.

Gulf tankers

Trump's administration has accused Iran of being behind the explosions on tankers in the Gulf of Oman, a vital oil shipping route.

The United States released a video last week it said showed Iran's Revolutionary Guard was behind the latest attacks near the Strait of Hormuz on the Norwegian-owned Front Altair, which was set ablaze, and the Japanese-owned Kokuka Courageous.

The U.S. military released additional imagery on Monday.

"Iran is responsible for the attack based on video evidence and the resources and proficiency needed to quickly remove the unexploded limpet mine," Central Command said

in a statement.

A U.S. defense official, speaking on condition of anonymity, said the new deployment included forces who operate the U.S. military's airborne intelligence, surveillance and reconnaissance capabilities that help detect threats and scoop up sensitive imagery and intelligence. The deployment would also involve personnel who can strengthen protection of U.S. troops already deployed to the region.

Iran's armed forces chief of staff, Maj. Gen. Mohammad Baqeri, denied on Monday that Tehran was behind the attacks and said if the Islamic Republic decided to block the strategic Strait of Hormuz shipping lane, it would do so publicly.

The secretary of Iran's Supreme National Security Council, Ali Shamkhani, said Tehran was responsible for security in the Gulf and urged U.S. forces to leave the region, state TV

Britain's Hammond 'prepared to resign' over May's spending plans

(Reuters) - British Finance Minister Philip Hammond is "prepared to resign" over Prime Minister Theresa May's legacy spending plans, ITV said on Tuesday, citing the Press Association

Senior government sources told the Press Association that tension between officials at the Treasury and the prime minister's office had reached boiling point over May's spending intentions, according to ITV.

May's intention to spend up to 9 billion pounds (\$11.3 billion) each year on education over three years, including plans to build new schools and pay teachers higher wages have sparked tension, it said, citing a

well-placed source.

May's chancellor Hammond opposes those plans and is prepared to resign, in what would be an extraor-
