Buenas yan Håfa Adai! This memorandum is respectfully requesting approval to create a new position and establish class specifications for the abovementioned position into the classified service. This is based on a request to create the position by the Department of Agriculture, Biosecurity Division, dated June 23, 2017.

The Department of Agriculture seeks to create a new position to provide scientific expertise in the identification and classification of species of plant disease agents; determining pathogen distributions and recommend response strategies to ecological pests and bioterrorism threats concerning the various plant disease agents on Guam.

The incumbent is responsible for developing specific programs and activities related to the prevention of invasive species and plant pathogens; seeks external funding sources to further the Department of Agriculture's plant disease initiatives and its economic development programs; and provides assistance in the enforcement of local, federal and international rules, regulations and laws concerning the importation and transportation of diseased plants and propagative material.

The creation of this position is vital for the protection of Guam's natural resources from invasive species by developing and implementing eradication plans; allowing a more proactive approach and response to all issues including imports and exports of goods; educating the communities about invasive species plant pathogens and providing more public awareness. In addition, the Plant Pathologist will assist the Department of Agriculture's forestry and conservation programs through research and diagnosis of plant diseases to determine agents responsible for disease and recommendations to mitigate environmental impacts and other problems caused by invasive species.

NATURE OF WORK IN THIS CLASS:

Administer plant disease programs and activities for the Department of Agriculture. Employees in this class work independently and may supervise the work of technical staff and other cooperating agencies involved in plant disease programs.

Under the general direction of the Director of Agriculture, this position exercises decision making in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, principles and program objectives concerning importation, transportation and prevention of plant pathogens.

<u>ILLUSTRATIVE EXAMPLES OF WORK</u>: (Any one position may not include all the duties listed, nor do the examples cover all the duties which may be performed.)

Identifies and classifies species and varieties of plant disease agents in agricultural imports and materials; determines the species that harbor or transmit disease

Develops and maintains the Department of Agriculture's list of plant pathogens

Keeps abreast of current research, methods and practices pertaining to plant pathology

Conducts research and compares healthy and diseased plants to determine effects and symptoms of diseased condition to determine agents responsible for disease

Performs laboratory diagnosis of plant diseases to improve plant health and reduce and/or eliminate plant disease

Determine how pathogens attack plants and the effects of environmental conditions on disease development

Improves agricultural and horticultural efficiency and assists forestry and conservation programs in the protection of Guam's natural resources from invasive species

Facilitate the development of an interagency monitoring plan and conduct activities, build partnerships and collaboration with community organizations, leaders and related agencies on invasive species programs

Formulates procedures and guidelines for assigned plant pathology programs

Develops methods to combat plant diseases and implements plant pathology program goals and plans, response strategies and disease prevention

Studies and determines plant pathogen distribution and recommends methods to control and prevent importation and spread of plant pathogens

Reviews, comments and maintains records, data and correspondence on all plans and activities relating to plant pathology; prepares necessary reports, publications, testimonies and position papers as required

Seeks external funding sources to further the Department of Agriculture's plant disease initiatives and further its economic development programs



Assists in commodity market development and export market enhancement efforts

Assist in the enforcement of local, federal and international rules, regulations, laws and agreements concerning the importation and transportation of diseased plants and plant propagative material

Coordinates with professionals of other disciplines, local and federal officials on matters relating to plant pathology, entomology, botany, forestry and horticulture

Participates and represents the department in public forums, conferences and meetings

Performs related duties as required

Knowledge of the taxonomy and systematics of plant pathogens

Knowledge of the biology of plants

Knowledge of Guam's invasive species and plant pathogen database

Ability to plan, direct, coordinate and supervise plant disease programs

Ability to monitor, evaluate and assess the effectiveness of pest control programs and preventative measures; recommends solutions

Ability to evaluate and analyze research, monitor data collection management and related databases to determine plant pathogen trends

Ability to manage, coordinate and implement plans within government agencies and/or interest groups.

Ability to maintain records and prepare reports

Ability to apply pertinent laws, rules, regulations and other program guidelines

Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with employees, staff, representatives of both local and federal governmental, professional and community organizations, and the general public.

Skill in problem solving, decision making, and interpersonal management in accordance with appropriate program guidelines

Skill in organization, leadership, public relations and communications



SUBJECT:

Proposed Creation of Position - Plant Pathologist

Submitted for your review are the proposed job specifications for the creation of the position of *Plant Pathologist*.

Justification: The Department of Agriculture's role in defending Guam from agricultural or ecological pests or bioterrorism threats is to help provide scientific expertise and backstopping here at the local level. Our Guam/USDA Plant Inspection Facility can serve as a focal point in these efforts. One of the requirements for the Plant Inspection Facility is to have available the expertise of a Plant Pathologist to assist in the enforcement of international, federal and local regulations concerning plant disease agents. The Plant Pathologist will also assist all of Guam in determining pathogen distributions, bringing plant diseases under control, and assisting our forestry and conservation programs. The incumbent will also assist in commodity market development and export market enhancement efforts that are ongoing. These are expected to improve and diversify Guam's economy.

The scientific and regulatory position of Plant Pathologist does not currently exist in the Government of Guam. The newly created Biosecurity Division has sufficient funding for this position. Therefore, I am requesting your assistance in the expeditious creation of the position so that we can proceed with recruitment as soon as possible.

Office of the Territorial Entomologist:

Plans, supervises, directs, coordinates, and reviews Biosecurity Division activities and programs. Represents Division, Department and the Government of Guam at local, regional, national and international meetings and organizations. Plans, implements and supervises pest management projects and related activities. Formulates, implements and enforces rules and regulations pertinent to biosecurity, plant protection and quarantine. Manages agricultural quarantine effort for Department of Agriculture. Identifies insects, plant diseases, weeds or other organisms on agricultural imports and materials, products for export or found in the environment. Determines appropriate pest eradication or control procedures and measures to follow to protect the local agricultural industry and the environment.

Plant Inspection Facility Section:

Operates federally certified plant inspection station for Guam and the region. Issues import permits, export certificates and conducts other activities to allow imports and exports of agricultural products. Maintains laboratory, inspection and other infrastructure to support biosecurity activities. Enforces federal and Guam laws and regulations to insure public and environmental safety of product movements. Monitors products offered for sale to insure safety and legality.


Invasive Species Section:

Monitors for the introduction into Guam of new invasive species, especially new destructive plant or animal pests or diseases. Protects, manages and conserves Guam's natural resources from the effects of invasive alien species. Implements appropriate response actions when new invasive species are discovered. Conducts research to improve the efficacy of pest response activities. Assists farmers, other stakeholders and the general public to minimize the destructive effects of newly introduced invasive species. Educates stakeholders in the importance of agricultural quarantine and biosecurity and the methods that can be used to limit detrimental effects.
