BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that the Guam Community College (GCC) is essential to developing, cultivating,
- 4 and producing educated citizens. GCC serves as a higher education institution with

a purpose of advancing careers and technical education, not only for residents of
 Guam but for individuals from the Asia-Pacific region.

ILiheslaturan Guåhan further finds that during FY 2009, GCC received funds from the GCC Endowment Fund, and the requested funds were used for the construction of a parking lot. Additional funds were used to purchase multiple Dell Power Edge T410 servers to better assist students, faculty, and visitors, and these upgrades were necessary given the increasing development and enrollment at GCC.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate funds from the GCC Endowment Fund, as of Fiscal Year 2019, to the Guam Community College.

Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Community College. Up to the sum of Two Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Six Hundred Forty Dollars and Ninety-eight Cents (\$254,640.98) is appropriated from the GCC Endowment Fund, as of Fiscal Year 2019, to the Guam Community College for the purposes enumerated in § 221306 of Article 13, Chapter 22, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, for Fiscal Year 2020.

- 6 funds to purchase library equipment and to modernize the necessary areas for
- 7 students, visitors and faculty.
- 8 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate funds from
- 9 the UOG Higher Education Endowment Fund, as of Fiscal Year 2019, to the
