



AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE UP TO THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED FORTY DOLLARS AND NINETY-EIGHT CENTS (\$254,640.98) FROM THE GCC ENDOWMENT FUND, AS OF FISCAL YEAR 2019, TO THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOR THE PURPOSES ENUMERATED IN § 221306 OF ARTICLE 13, CHAPTER 22, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Guam Community College (GCC) is essential to developing, cultivating,
4 and producing educated citizens. GCC serves as a higher education institution with

1 a purpose of advancing careers and technical education, not only for residents of
2 Guam but for individuals from the Asia-Pacific region.

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that during FY 2009, GCC received funds
4 from the GCC Endowment Fund, and the requested funds were used for the
5 construction of a parking lot. Additional funds were used to purchase multiple Dell
6 Power Edge T410 servers to better assist students, faculty, and visitors, and these
7 upgrades were necessary given the increasing development and enrollment at GCC.

8 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate funds from
9 the GCC Endowment Fund, as of Fiscal Year 2019, to the Guam Community
10 College.

11 **Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Community College.** Up to the
12 sum of Two Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Six Hundred Forty Dollars and Ninety-
13 eight Cents (\$254,640.98) is appropriated from the GCC Endowment Fund, as of
14 Fiscal Year 2019, to the Guam Community College for the purposes enumerated in
15 § 221306 of Article 13, Chapter 22, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, for Fiscal Year
16 2020.



1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the University of Guam (UOG) is essential to developing, cultivating, and

1 producing educated citizens. UOG serves as a higher education institution with a
2 purpose of serving the people of Guam and the Micronesia/Pacific region.

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that during FY 2006 and FY 2008, the
4 University of Guam utilized funds from the UOG Higher Education Endowment
5 Fund to make improvements to the RFK Public Library; and, also used the requested
6 funds to purchase library equipment and to modernize the necessary areas for
7 students, visitors and faculty.

8 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate funds from
9 the UOG Higher Education Endowment Fund, as of Fiscal Year 2019, to the
10 University of Guam.

11 **Section 2. Appropriation to the University of Guam.** Up to the sum of
12 Four Hundred Sixty-eight Thousand Three Hundred Eighteen Dollars and Seventy-
13 seven Cents (\$468,318.77) is appropriated from the UOG Higher Education
14 Endowment Fund, as of Fiscal Year 2019, to the University of Guam for the
15 purposes enumerated in § 221305 of Article 13, Chapter 22, Title 5, Guam Code
16 Annotated.
