# Winston leads Spartans to win over Wolverines

No. 14 Michigan State 87. No. 12 Michigan 69: Cassius Winston scored a career-high 32 points and Xavier Tillman fell one point short of his career high with 20, leading host Michigan State to a victory over Michigan on Sunday.

The Spartans (12-3, 4-0 Big Ten) were ahead the entire game, leading by as many as 13 points in the first half and earning a bigger cushion in the second, to beat their rivals for a fourth consecutive time. Michigan State has won seven straight and is the only Big Ten team without a conference loss.

The Wolverines (10-4, 1-2) have lost four of their last seven games after starting 7-0 and going from

faced Michigan State for the first time as a coach after

going 5-1 in the series as a player. Howard

Michigan center Jon Teske fouled out after scoring four of his 15 points in the second half. Zavier Simpson had 14 points and eight assists while Franz Wagner added 10 points for the Walverines

Winston and Tillman did more than just score. Winston had nine assists and Tillman had II rebounds.

No. 20 Dayton 80, Saint Joseph's 67: Trey Landers and Ryan Mikesell each scored 18 points as Dayton (11-3, 2-0 Atlantic 10) fought off some sluggishness and pulled away for a win over Saint Joseph's (3-11, 0-2) in Philadelphia.

Ibit Watson and Obi Toppin added 15 points apiece and Jalen Crutcher scored 10 for the Flyers

Ryan Daly scored 22 points to lead Saint Joseph's. Cameron Brown scored 16 and Myles Douglas had 15.

The Flyers ended a ninegame losing streak at Hawk Hill dating back to a 66-62 win on Jan. 29, 2000. But Saint Joseph's, which has lost 10 of 11 and was coming off an 84-52 loss at Rich-mond on Thursday night, managed to keep it close for much of the afternoon.

Dayton struggled from the floor, never getting into the offensive flow it showed on Thursday night during an 84-58 win over La Salle. That allowed Saint Joseph's to hang around in the first half despite shooting 11 of 27.

The Hawks sprinted out to a six-point lead less than a minute into the second half thanks to two 3-pointers by Brown. Dayton responded with an 11-2 run to reclaim the lead, and the yers did not trail again. Sonayton took control of S Flyers did not trail again.


