



1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000) are hereby
3 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Works (the
4 "Department") to provide sidewalks, auto barriers, picnic facilities,
5 showers, pavilions and shelters, demolish the old restroom, and to
6 landscape and otherwise beautify Nimitz Beach, Agat.

7 Section 2. Ninety-Five Thousand Dollars (\$95,000) are appropriated
8 from the General Fund to the Department to improve the shelters and picnic
9 facilities at Afleje Beach, Agat and to landscape the same.

1 Section 3. Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) are appropriated from the
2 General Fund to the Department to improve the basketball court at Nimitz
3 Beach, Agat.

4 Section 4. Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) are appropriated from
5 the General Fund to the Department to improve the Agat Basketball Court.

6 Section 5. The Agat Municipal Planning Council shall coordinate the
7 projects authorized by this Act with the Department of Parks and
8 Recreation and the Department. The contracting officer for the projects
9 shall be the Director of the Department.

Dear Senator Gutierrez:

I want to thank the Legislature for their support on the Governor's Capitol Improvement Project as recommended in the FY 1990 Budget submissions.

I am testifying on Bill No. 802, an act to appropriate the sum of two hundred sixty thousand dollars for improvements to the recreational facilities in Agat and at Nimitz Beach.

Of the three areas proposed for improvement funding, two - Nimitz Beach and Rizal Beach, known as Afilleje Memorial Beach Park, are under the jurisdiction of the Department of Parks and Recreation. Regarding the Nimitz Beach, we recommend that the scope of work listed in Section 1 of Bill No. 802 be expanded to include demolition of the old restroom and storage facility and to construct picnic facilities that are needed.

Section 2 appropriates \$95,000 for improvements for the shelters at Rizal Beach. We would recommend that the scope be expanded to state picnic facilities including shelters.

Section 3 is to construct a basketball court at Nimitz Beach to serve the youths from that area of Nimitz that has no recreational facilities.

We support Section 5 to renovate improving the lighting at the existing Agat Multipurpose Court which is highly used by the people of Agat. The facility plays a major role in successful recreational programs for Agat.

Therefore, with these changes, we recommend enactment of Bill No. 802.

BACKGROUND

A public hearing on Bill No. 802 was conducted by the Committee on Ways and Means on Wednesday, July 19, 1989 at the Legislative Session Hall.

Bill No. 802 would appropriate Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$260,000) from the General Fund to the Department of Parks and Recreation for improvements to the recreational facilities in Agat and at Nimitz Beach.

TESTIMONY

Director of Parks and Recreation, Anthony C. Mariano, submitted written testimony in support of Bill No. 802. Mr. Mariano recommends that Section 1 of Bill 802 be expanded to include the demolition of the old restroom and storage facility. He recommends that the projects at the Rizal Beach include building picnic facilities as well as picnic shelters.

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on Ways and Means recommends that Bill No. 802, as substituted, be passed by the Twentieth Guam Legislature.
