Enclosed please find a copy of Bill No. 137 (COR), "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY TO SET ROOM RATE ADJUSTMENTS THROUGH THE ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION LAW, AND TO CITE THE ACT AS THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL ROOM RATE ADJUSTMENT ACT.", which I have signed into law today as Public Law No. 24-10.


This legislation will allow the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority to adjust room rates according to the procedures of the Administrative Adjudication Law. This will allow some changes in the charges for room rates, but will probably not greatly increase the revenues of the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority.

The hospital room rates were increased about 10% recently, and although they could be further adjusted upwards, the Administrative Adjudication Law requires a procedure which includes published notice to the public, a public hearing, preparation of proposed new rates in bill form, approval by the Governor, and finally transmittal to the Legislature where the new rates must wait 45 days plus 7 legislative days before they are put into effect.

The legislation is beneficial to the hospital's cash flow, and therefore I have signed it into law.



AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY TO SET ROOM RATE ADJUSTMENTS THROUGH THE ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION LAW, AND TO CITE THE ACT AS THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL ROOM RATE ADJUSTMENT ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

1 Section 1. Legislative Intent. The Guam Memorial Hospital Authority is a semi-autonomous agency that had its ability to generate its own revenue source 2 through its services revoked by P.L. 18-26, and restored by P.L. 23-22, by using a 3 "Pricing Model." Although the Authority has been given a fifteen percent (15%) 4 rate increase across the board by P.L. 23-20, the Authority is again seeking 5 legislative subsidy through the General Fund, and the amount of subsidy required is 6 increasing with each legislative request. This subsidy is an additional burden to the 7 taxpayers that are not using the hospital patient services when it should be the 8 patients or their health insurance provider(s) paying the Authority for these services. 9 It is also well documented that the Authority has difficulty in producing easily 10 11 certifiably, correct billing documents and in following the mandate of Title 10 Guam 12 Code Annotated §80105.

13 Recognizing that room rates are an easily certifiable, and generally, an undisputed service, amounting to appropriately twenty percent (20%) of the 14 Authority's revenue source, it is therefore the intent of this legislation to allow the 15 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority the rate setting authority for room rate 16 adjustments through the Administrative Adjudication Law process, without 17 complicating the present billing procedure of the hospital; and further to reduce 18 subsequent hospital subsidy requests by providing an additional revenue source, and 19 exempting room rate adjustments from the mandate of the GMHA Pricing Model, 20 10 GCA §80105.1. 21

Section 2. Brief Title. This Act may be cited or referred to as, "The
Guam Memorial Hospital Room Rate Adjustment Act."

Section 3. Authorization to Implement Room Rate Adjustments. The
 Guam Memorial Hospital Authority is hereby authorized to implement room rate
 adjustments through the Administrative Adjudication Law.
