Dear Speaker Unpingco:

Enclosed please find Bill No. 701 (COR), "AN ACT TO ADD §7(c) TO P.L. NO. 24-171, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING UNEXPENDED FISCAL YEAR 1998 FUNDS FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE I TANO'-TA LAND USE PLAN TO BE CARRIED OVER TO FISCAL YEAR 1999", which I have signed into law today as **Public Law No. 24-291**.

The "I Tano'-ta Land Use Plan went into effect on April 17, 1998 according to the provisions of Public Law No. 24-171. That public law recited that the Guam Planning Council should perform certain activities within 12 months from the enactment of Public Law No. 24-171.

When Public Law No. 24-171 was enacted, the appropriations were made from Fiscal Year 1998, however, the work to be accomplished was to extend for a period of one year. In April, 1998, when Public Law No. 24-171 went into effect, however, there were only 5-1/2 months left of Fiscal Year 1998.

This legislation allows the Fiscal Year 1998 appropriation to be carried over for the remainder of the 12 month performance period, to expire on April 30, 1999. This legislation removes the inconsistency between the expiration of the appropriation and the time frame to accomplish the work.

The Committee on Finance and Taxation held a public hearing on Wednesday, July 22, 1998 at 2:00 p. m. in the I Liheslaturan Guåhan Public Hearing Room to hear public testimony on Bill 675 (COR). Pursuant to the requirements of Public Law 24-109, a reminder memorandum was sent on Friday, July 20, 1998. Additionally, a Public Hearing Notice was announced and published on Sunday, July 19, 1998 issues of the Pacific Daily News.

III. BACKGROUND ON BILL 701:

Findings of Necessity and Declaration of Purposes.

The proposed legislation attempts to add a new Subsection (c) to Section 7 of Public Law Number 24-117 (Bill Number 526(LS)) to read: "The sums appropriated by Subsections (a) and (b) of this section for the Fiscal Year 1998 implementation of the Plan are for the purpose of funding the twelve (12) month Plan implementation Schedule (Amended), as adopted by the Territorial Planning Council in the I Tano'-ta Master Implementation Plan (April 1997). The

appropriated sums shall be apportioned by the above agencies and departments as necessary over the twelve (12) month period ending April 30, 1999, to timely discharge their respective responsibilities pursuant to the Implementation Schedule. Any funds unexpended in Fiscal Year 1998 shall carry over for expenditures in fiscal Year 1999 for the purposes authorized in this section."

SUMMARY OF TESTIMONIES:

FAVORABLE:

Mr. Mike Gawel from the GEPA testified in favor of the proposed legislation, Bill 701. It was disclosed in the public hearing that funds unexpended in Fiscal Year 1998 will need to be carried over to Fiscal Year 1999 because it will be in FY 1999 that the most work need to be accomplished for the implementation of the I Tano'-ta Master Plan.

UNFAVORABLE:

No one testified against Bill 701.

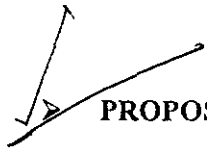

BILL 700: AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 12, TITLE 12 GCA AND TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 32604 TO ARTICLE 6, CHAPTER 32, TITLE 5, GCA MANDATING THAT OVERALL OPERATIONS AND RATES CHARGED BY CABLE OPERATORS SHALL BE UNDER THE OVERSIGHT, SUPERVISION AND APPROVAL OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

BILL 701: AN ACT TO ADD NEW PROVISIONS TO SECTION 7, P.L. 24-171, THE "TANO'-TA LAND USE PLAN", RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING UNEXPENDED FY '98 FUNDS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLAN TO BE CARRIED OVER TO 1999.

BILL 702: AN ACT TO ESTABLISH A SPECIAL FUND TO BE USED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF APPROPRIATED FUNDS FOR COMPETITIVE INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES. THIS SPECIAL FUND SHALL BE KNOWN AS THE "INTERSCHOLASTIC PARITY FUND," AND SHALL BE USED TO PROVIDE PARITY TO COMPETITIVE INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES BASED ON ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT.

BILL 703: AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & RECREATION OFF-ISLAND SPORTS TRAVEL FUND TO SUBSIDIZE THE COST OF AIR TRAVEL FOR THE GUAM NATIONAL BASEBALL TEAM.

BILL 705: AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNOR OF GUAM TO SELL AN ABANDONED PRE-WAR BULL-CART TRAIL IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO.
