Dear Speaker Unpingco:

Enclosed please find Substitute Bill No. 706 (LS), "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE GUAM LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL, INC., HOST NATION COMMITTEE OF THE 1998 SENIOR AND BIG LITTLE LEAGUE FAR EAST TOURNAMENT, AND OTHER SPORTS-RELATED PURPOSES", which I have signed into law today as **Public Law No. 24-300**.

This legislation appropriates an additional \$69,800 for payment of expenses of off-island sports competitions which have already occurred. It also reduces the amount previously appropriated in Public Law No. 24-292 for the October, 1998 trip to Arizona of the Guam National Baseball Teams by separating out \$10,000 of the previously appropriated \$50,000 to be re-allocated instead to the Southern High School Baseball Field.







1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guahan*

3 finds that due to Guam's participation in the 1998 Senior and Big Little  
4 League Far East Tournament as the Host Nation, there are expenses required  
5 of Guam Little League Baseball, Inc. to ensure a successful tournament, and  
6 promote camaraderie among the teams participating in the Far East  
7 Tournament.

8           *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that the Tournament identified herein may  
9 begin *before* the enactment of this Act. Hence, Guam Little League Baseball,  
10 Inc. may have to expend its own funds in advance of the appropriation  
11 contained herein. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* intends that *if* they expend funds that  
12 they be reimbursed, but in no event shall the government make total  
13 expenditures in excess of the appropriation of Nineteen Thousand Eight  
14 Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00) contained herein.

15           **Section 2. Appropriation for Guam Little League Baseball, Inc.**

16 Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00) is hereby authorized  
17 and appropriated from the General Fund to Guam Little League Baseball, Inc.  
18 for the purpose of subsidizing costs incurred for the 1998 Senior and Big Little  
19 League Far East Tournament.

20           **Section 3. Appropriation for Guam Masters Baseball, Inc.** Twenty-

21 five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General  
22 Fund to Guam Masters Baseball, Inc. for travel and other expenses to be  
23 incurred during the 1998 Masters Baseball Tournament ("Tournament") in  
24 Gold Coast, Australia on October 29 through November 10, 1998. In the event

1 that Guam Masters Baseball, Inc. expends funds for travel and other expenses  
2 *before* the enactment of this Act or *before* their travel and other expenses can be  
3 paid for by the government for the Tournament, they shall be entitled to  
4 reimbursement, but in no event exceed the appropriated amounts herein to be  
5 expended in total on the Tournament.

6 **Section 4. Appropriation for Guam Hal's Angels Football**  
7 **Association.** Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby  
8 appropriated from the General Fund to Guam Hal's Angels Football  
9 Association for travel and other expenses to be incurred in Honolulu, Hawaii.

10 **Section 5.** Section 2 of Public Law Number 24-292 is hereby *amended* to  
11 read as follows:

12 "Section 2. Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) is hereby  
13 appropriated for the General Fund to the Department of Parks and  
14 Recreation Off-Island Sports Fund to be allocated in the following  
15 manner:

16 a) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the repair and  
17 renovation of the Southern High School Baseball Field.

18 b) Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) to be allocated to  
19 the Guam National Baseball Teams to supplement the cost of their  
20 off-Island travel expenses."

21 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Law or its  
22 application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to  
23 law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this  
24 Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application,  
25 and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.

Dear Vice-Speaker Blaz:

**Hafa Adai and greetings from the players and volunteers of Guam Little League Baseball!**

Thank you for the kind invitation to testify on Bill No. 706 relative to appropriating funds for the expenses duly incurred as host nation for this year's Senior and Big League Far East Tournaments.

These two regional tournaments were held on July 12 to 19 at the Paseo Stadium and involved four countries for the Senior division, ages 13-15, and two countries for the Big League division, ages 16-18. For the Seniors, the four all-star delegations represented the Republic of the Philippines, Hong Kong, our neighbors - the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas, and our island of Guam. The Big League level involved the CNMI and Guam. There were more than 170 Little Leaguers, officials and delegation observers involved.

Mr. Chairman and Members of this Committee, you may recall that last year, our Island also hosted the Senior Little League Far East Tournament. The participants then included Guam, the CNMI, the Philippines, Hong Kong, and Palau. Due to the unrest of several countries in Asia, all the expected participants strongly urged that this year's tournament be held here on Guam. This bears well with the stability that our beloved island portrays in the midst of much turmoil around the Pacific Rim.

Please note that the Guam Little League did not offer to have the Tournaments held here this summer. Mr. Mamuro Itoh, Little League Far East Administrator, conveyed the urgent request on behalf of numerous Little League organizations.

Subsequently, with all factors considered, and even in spite of financial constraints Guam is experiencing, having these events here was the best option available.

In essence, a concensus was reached in late April by the Guam Little League district staff, composed of my<sup>self</sup>, retired Mayor Greg M. Borja as Assistant District Administrator, Treasurer Jose Santos, Mayors' Council Executive Director Frank Camacho (also Central League President), Southern League President Frank ~~Camacho~~ <sup>Aguiar</sup> and Northern League President Greg Calvo Jr.

In sincerest humility, Guam Little League sought the support of Governor Gutierrez, Speaker Unpingco, Senator Carlotta Leon Guerrero, Senator Lamorena, among many GovGuam leaders, for the funding, bus transportation, and meals for the visiting delegations. The cooperation of the ITC Hotel, under its President, Mr. Dock In Cho, is gratefully appreciated for their generosity in the accommodations of the six delegations, involving more than \$5,000 in in-kind contribution and discounts.

While we were not as successful as last year's hosting of seven days of breakfasts, lunches and dinners in the aggregate amount of over \$10,500, the Host Nation Committee was still able to solicit hosting sponsorships from Speaker Unpingco and the 24th Guam Legislature, MacDonalds, ~~and our organization,~~ <sup>Comtee Communicators, Pepsi</sup> ~~in the~~ with an estimated of about \$1,600.00

The total income generated are as follows:

1. Tournament Fees	\$ 4,000.00
2. Donations	\$ 200.00
3. Stadium gate donations	\$ 2,031.00
4. In-kind contributions	
a. Accommodations	\$ 5,110.00
b. Hosting (estimated)	\$ 1,600.00
Total:	\$12,027.00

Total Expenditures incurred, are as follows:

1. Accommodations	\$11,720.00
2. Hosting	\$ 6,269.51
3. Tournament	\$ 951.00
4. Stadium Operations	\$ 914.00
Total:	\$19,854.51

In summary, the outstanding obligations are as follows:

1. Accommodations	\$ 6,610.00
2. Hosting	<u>\$ 5,279.00</u>
Total:	\$11,889.00

Therefore, on behalf of the Guam Little League and the 1998 Senior and Big League Tournaments Host Nation Committee, I am respectfully requesting the kind support of you, Vice Speaker Blaz and the Members of the Committee on Finance and Taxation, and the rest of the Members of the Twenty-Fourth Guam Legislature to consider Bill No. 706 in finalizing the financial obligations of two regional tournaments hosted on behalf of the youth and people of the Island of Guam.

**AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND APPROPRIATE  
FUNDS TO GUAM LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL,  
INC., HOST NATION COMMITTEE OF THE 1998  
SENIOR AND BIG LITTLE LEAGUE FAR EAST  
TOURNAMENT, AND OTHER SPORTS-RELATED  
PURPOSES.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guahan*

3 finds that due to Guam's participation in the 1998 Senior and Big Little  
4 League Far East Tournament as the Host Nation, there are expenses required  
5 of Guam Little League Baseball, Inc. to ensure a successful tournament, and  
6 promote camaraderie among the teams participating in the Far East  
7 Tournament.

8           *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that the Tournament identified herein may  
9 begin *before* the enactment of this Act. Hence, Guam Little League Baseball,  
10 Inc. may have to expend its own funds in advance of the appropriation  
11 contained herein. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* intends that *if* they expend funds that  
12 they be reimbursed, but in no event shall the government make total  
13 expenditures in excess of the appropriation of Nineteen Thousand Eight  
14 Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00) contained herein.

15           **Section 2. Appropriation for Guam Little League Baseball, Inc.**

16 Nineteen Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$19,800.00) is hereby authorized  
17 and appropriated from the General Fund to Guam Little League Baseball, Inc.  
18 for the purpose of subsidizing costs incurred for the 1998 Senior and Big Little  
19 League Far East Tournament.

20           **Section 3. Appropriation for Guam Masters Baseball, Inc.** Twenty-

21 five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the General  
22 Fund to Guam Masters Baseball, Inc. for travel and other expenses to be  
23 incurred during the 1998 Masters Baseball Tournament ("Tournament") in  
24 Gold Coast, Australia on October 29 through November 10, 1998. In the event

1 that Guam Masters Baseball, Inc. expends funds for travel and other expenses  
2 *before* the enactment of this Act or *before* their travel and other expenses can be  
3 paid for by the government for the Tournament, they shall be entitled to  
4 reimbursement, but in no event exceed the appropriated amounts herein to be  
5 expended in total on the Tournament.

6 **Section 4. Appropriation for Guam Hal's Angels Football**  
7 **Association.** Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby  
8 appropriated from the General Fund to Guam Hal's Angels Football  
9 Association for travel and other expenses to be incurred in Honolulu, Hawaii.

10 **Section 5.** Section 2 of Public Law Number 24-292 is hereby *amended* to  
11 read as follows:

12 **"Section 2.** Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) is hereby  
13 appropriated for the General Fund to the Department of Parks and  
14 Recreation Off-Island Sports Fund to be allocated in the following  
15 manner:

- 16 a) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) for the repair and  
17 renovation of the Southern High School Baseball Field.
- 18 b) Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) to be allocated to  
19 the Guam National Baseball Teams to supplement the cost of their  
20 off-Island travel expenses."

21 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Law or its  
22 application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to  
23 law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this  
24 Law which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application,  
25 and to this end the provisions of this Law are severable.
