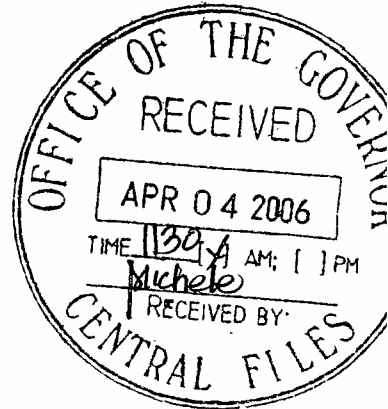



1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.**

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the villages of Yigo and Mangilao have
4 increased significantly in their respective resident populations. In the 2000

1 population census, the number of people residing in the village of Yigo increased
 2 tremendously by thirty seven percent (37%) between 1990 and 2000, becoming the
 3 second most populated village community in Guam with a resident population of
 4 nineteen thousand four hundred seventy four (19,474) people. The village of
 5 Mangilao also experienced a twenty six percent (26%) increase in its resident
 6 population in the same time frame, reaching a population of thirteen thousand three
 7 hundred thirteen (13,313) people.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further recognizes that the villages of Dededo,
 9 Tamuning and Barrigada (which represent the first, third and fifth most populated
 10 villages in Guam, respectively) presently have Vice-Mayors.

11 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide the people of
 12 Yigo and Mangilao with additional representation and support through the creation
 13 of Vice-Mayor positions, which shall be filled at the next islandwide elections
 14 conducted for Mayors and Vice-Mayors.

15 **Section 2. Establishment of Vice-Mayor Positions for the Villages of**
 16 **Yigo and Mangilao, Guam.** §40101 of Chapter 40, Division 4, Title 5, Guam
 17 Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

18 “§40101. **Number of Mayors and Vice-Mayors.** There shall be a Mayor
 19 and/or Vice-Mayor for the municipalities and villages of Guam as indicated in the
 20 following table:

16 **Section 3. Election to Fill Newly Created Vice-Mayoral Positions for**
17 **Yigo and Mangilao.** The newly created Vice-Mayoral positions for the villages of
18 Yigo and Mangilao shall be filled at the next islandwide election for Mayors and
19 Vice-Mayors, and said election shall be conducted in the same manner as filling
20 other Mayor or Vice-Mayor positions in accordance with existing laws.

21 The additional budgetary requirements created by the establishment of the
22 Vice-Mayoral positions for Yigo and Mangilao shall be incorporated into the
23 Mayors Council of Guam’s budgetary request for every fiscal year beginning in
24 FY 2007.

25 **Section 4.** The Mayors Council shall study, investigate, and report to *I*
26 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* regarding how to best structure the Mayor’s Offices,
27 including, but not limited to, the need for Vice-Mayors, the desirability of electing

1 Mayors and Vice-Mayors on a single ticket, the need for Administrative Services
2 Officers and other positions, their budgets, and responsibilities to their
3 communities. The report shall be submitted on or before September 30, 2006.

4 **Section 5. Severability Clause.** *If* any provision of this Act or its
5 application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall *not*
6 affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
7 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
8 Act are severable.

I. OVERVIEW

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Individuals that appeared before the Committee to present oral and written testimony on the bill were as follows:

Nito Blas, Mayor of Mangilao, written testimony In Support of Bill No. 152. Mayor Blas said that he supports the measure.

Robert Lizama, Mayor of Yigo, in support of Bill No. 152. Mayor Lizama said that he is submitting an approximate two hundred signatures (petitions) of Yigo residents who support the need for a vice mayor in their village. He said he has been the Mayor of Yigo for nine years and has seen the village grow significantly. He said currently there are approximately twenty thousand residents in Yigo. He said he is concerned of the budget breakdown for the various villages and is seeking the support of the legislature in providing a larger budget for his village.

Discussion:

Senator Kasperbauer asked Mayor Lizama if he is more favorable of the idea of an Administrative Officer Position for his office rather than a Vice Mayor Position? Mayor Lizama and Mayor Blas both said yes, with the intent that the AO Position be salaried above \$30,000. per annum to attract potential applicants. Mayor Lizama said he would like to fill the AO Position with an individual who could assess and care for the needs of the community while he is away from the office or busy with other duties of his office.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on General and Omnibus Matters finds that the intent of Bill No. 152 would allow for a new elected position of vice mayor to be represented in villages that have populated significantly, in reference to the villages of Mangilao and Yigo. The added representation of the vice mayor will contribute to the resident's demand for community representation and governmental services in the community level of operations. The new elected position of vice mayor for these two villages would provide for assistance in the mayoral duties and daily tasks and management of community operations and supervision.

Accordingly, the Committee on General and Omnibus Matters to which BILL No. 152 (LS) was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan **TO DO PASS BILL No. 152 (LS)**, "An Act Relative To Providing Additional Representation And Support To The People In The Villages Of Yigo And Mangilao At The Municipal Level Through The Establishment Of A Vice-Mayor Position For Each Of These Villages, In Recognition Of The Growing Resident Population In These Areas As The Second And Fourth Most Heavily Populated Villages In Guam And To Address The Corresponding Increasing Needs Of Its Residents; Thus Amending §§40101, Chapter 40, Division 4, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated."

AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROVIDING ADDITIONAL REPRESENTATION AND SUPPORT TO THE PEOPLE IN THE VILLAGES OF YIGO AND MANGILAO AT THE MUNICIPAL LEVEL THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A VICE-MAYOR POSITION FOR EACH OF THESE VILLAGES, IN RECOGNITION OF THE GROWING RESIDENT POPULATION IN THESE AREAS AS THE SECOND AND FOURTH MOST HEAVILY POPULATED VILLAGES IN GUAM AND TO ADDRESS THE CORRESPONDING INCREASING NEEDS OF ITS RESIDENTS; THUS AMENDING §§40101, CHAPTER 40, DIVISION 4, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Intent and findings.**

3 The Liheslaturan Guahan finds that the villages of Yigo and
4 Mangilao have increased significantly in their respective resident
5 population. In the 2000 population census, the number of people residing
6 in the village of Yigo increased tremendously by 37% between 1990 and
7 2000, becoming the second most populated village community in Guam
8 with a resident population of 19,474 people. The village of Mangilao also

1 experienced a 26% increase in its resident population between the same
2 timeframe, reaching a population of 13,313 people. With the
3 corresponding increases in resident populations of these villages, it is
4 important that appropriate representation in the village leadership be
5 expanded to include a Vice-Mayor, which would provide additional
6 representational support to the villages of Yigo and Mangilao. This
7 recognizable increase in the community's population has called for
8 residents in the village to request that I Liheslaturan Guahan consider
9 providing a Vice-Mayor position to further support its community's needs.

10 I Liheslaturan Guahan further recognizes that the villages of Dededo,
11 Tamuning, and Barrigada (which represent the first, third, and fifth most
12 populated villages in Guam respectively) presently have Vice-Mayor
13 representation. The provision of a Vice-Mayor position would provide
14 additional support to the Mayors of Yigo and Mangilao and to the people
15 in these villages toward improving their quality of life for the increasing
16 number of residents.

17 Therefore, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guahan to provide the
18 people of Yigo and Mangilao with additional representation through the
19 provision of a Vice-Mayor position, which position shall be filled at the
20 next islandwide elections to be conducted for Mayors and Vice-Mayors.

21 **Section 2. Establishment of a Vice-Mayor Position for the Villages**
22 **of Yigo and Mangilao, Guam.**

1 §§40101 of Chapter 40, Division 4, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated,
 2 relative to Number of Mayors and Vice Mayors is hereby amended to read
 3 as follows:

4 **“§§40101. ~~Appointment~~; Number of Mayors and Vice-Mayors.**

5 There shall be a Mayor and/or Vice Mayor for the municipalities and
 6 villages of Guam as indicated in the following table:

6 ~~Notwithstanding the effective date of this Act, the Vice Mayor of~~
7 ~~Agana heights and of Chalan Pago and Ordot shall continue in office for~~

13 **Section 3. Election to Fill Newly Created Vice-Mayoral Positions**
14 **for Yigo and Mangilao.**

15 The newly created Vice-Mayoral positions as highlighted in Section 2
16 of this Act for the villages of Yigo and Mangilao shall be filled at the next
17 islandwide election cycle for Mayors and Vice-Mayors, and such election
18 shall be conducted in the same manner as filling other mayor or vice-
19 mayor positions in accordance with existing laws.

20 The additional budgetary requirements set forth through the
21 establishment of the vice-mayoral positions for Yigo and Mangilao shall be
22 incorporated into the Mayors' Council of Guam's budgetary request for the
23 applicable fiscal year.

1 **Section 4. Severability Clause.**

2 If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or
3 circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity shall not affect other
4 provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the
5 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act
6 are severable.
