



1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslatura* finds that Public  
3 Law No. 28-17 deappropriated Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from the Office

1 of Vice Speaker Joanne M.S. Brown to the University of Guam for the purchase of a  
2 Compost Turner and needed supplies to begin composting operations at the  
3 University of Guam's *Inarajan* Agricultural Experiment Station. The intent of Public  
4 Law 28-17 was to help the community realize the benefits of composting  
5 biodegradable waste, utilizing the technical expertise available at the University.  
6 This will provide a responsible alternative for the island to reduce the high volume of  
7 trash generated on Guam daily, and divert the waste stream from the overcrowded  
8 landfill.

9 *I Liheslatura* also finds that the University needs further monetary assistance  
10 in purchasing equipment, specifically, a Total Carbon/Nitrogen Analyzer, an  
11 instrument that will ensure that the compost product is at its optimum quality, and  
12 more importantly, that it is safe before it is applied to the environment.

13 **Section 2. Deappropriation and Reappropriation.** The sum of Sixteen  
14 Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) is hereby deappropriated from the sums appropriated  
15 to *I Liheslatura* for Fiscal Year 2006 and reappropriated to the University of Guam's  
16 Agricultural Experiment Station for the *sole* purpose of purchasing a Total  
17 Carbon/Nitrogen Analyzer and supplies needed for its operation. Notwithstanding  
18 any other law or rule, the Fiscal Officer of *I Liheslatura* is authorized to reduce the  
19 allotment to Vice Speaker Joanne M.S. Brown by an amount equal to the sum  
20 deappropriated by this Section.

21 **Section 3. Reappropriation of the Unexpended Sums of Section 2 of**  
22 **Public Law 28-17.** The University of Guam is hereby authorized to reappropriate the  
23 unexpended funds from Section 2 of Public Law 28-17 for the *sole* purpose of a Total  
24 Carbon/Nitrogen Analyzer.

25 **Section 4. Reporting.** One hundred and eighty (180) days after the  
26 enactment of this Act, the University of Guam's Agricultural Experiment Station shall

- 1 prepare financial reports on the expenditure of this appropriation for the President of
- 2 the University of Guam, who shall then submit the reports to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.







## **I. OVERVIEW**

The Executive Committee held a public hearing at 2:00 p.m. on January 17, 2006 in the Public Hearing Room, I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Public notice was given to all media (see facsimile confirmation page) on January 10 and January 16, 2006. Notice was placed in the PDN on January 13, 16 and 17, 2006.

## **II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY**

Individuals that appeared before the Committee to present oral and written testimony on the bill were as follows:

**Dr. Mohammed Golabi**, University of Guam, provided oral testimony in support of Bill No. 208 (EC) which would help the efforts of reducing the islands waste. Dr. Golabi gave a brief explanation for the need of a Carbon/Nitrogen Analyzer, and how the purchase of a compost turner through appropriation from Public Law 28-17 was an enhancement in teaching the community the importance of composting; helping to reduce the amount of biodegradable waste discarded daily. Dr. Golabi explained that the need for a total carbon/nitrogen analyzer is to monitor the amounts of carbon and nitrogen is produced by the compost turner. He stated that monitoring the amounts of carbon and nitrogen is a very important parameter in composting. Private citizens who have tried to compost failed due to the inaccurate levels of carbon and nitrogen in the compost piles. Dr. Golabi reported to the Committee the compost turner has been received and is being stored in the University of Guam's Yigo Experiment Station. He stated that the Inarajan experiment station did not provide enough space for storage and operation of the compost turner.

### **Comments:**

**Speaker Forbes** recognized that Public Law 28-17 was passed early last year and the compost turner was recently delivered. Speaker Forbes inquired when the money was released to the University of Guam to purchase the compost turner and why it took so long to purchase the machine.

**Dr. Golabi** stated the money was received around April and the procurement issues such as attaining on-island price quotations were not available. This forced the university to search for off-island vendors. Another issue was the selected vendor required full payment before the compost turner was shipped to Guam. This was resolved between the vendor and the university.

**Senator Won Pat** stated that she supports her intent of the bill, especially because it helps reduce waste produced on island. She added she also believes it should unanimously supported by the legislature.

**Vice Speaker Brown, author**, said she looks forward to the presentation of the equipment in use. She also stated, it was Dr. Golabi initial presentation a couple of years ago, showing the work done by the University's Graduate student in his program, which started the process of trying to get equipment to compost on a larger scale. Vice Speaker Brown expressed that composting is an effective way to deal with the biodegradable waste to produce products using a natural process that could enrich our soil, that would in return enhance farming and planting, Vice Speaker Brown stated her support of Dr. Golabi's program and commended him on his dedication and persistence.

**Senator Kasperbauer** asked if Dr. Golabi wanted to delete the word "Inarajan" from line 21 of page 2, so that it would be general and appropriate for the university to have the flexibility of moving the compost turner between agricultural stations.

Dr. Golabi stated that it would be a great idea.

### **III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION**

The Executive Committee finds that the intent of Bill No. 208, as amended, would provide the additional funding for the purchase of a total carbon/nitrogen analyzer needed by the University of Guam's Agricultural Experiment Station to conduct extensive research and method analysis of composting material. The committee further finds the funding deappropriated from the funds allocated to the Office of Vice Speaker Brown, I Liheslatura and reappropriated to the University of Guam's Agricultural Experiment Station will foster, encourage and strengthen scientific research to reduce material waste on our island.

Accordingly, the Executive Committee to which BILL No. 208 (EC) was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan **TO DO PASS BILL No. 208 (EC), as amended, "An Act To Appropriate Sixteen Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) From The Funds Of The Office Of Vice Speaker Joanne M.S. 

# Hearing on Cook School transfer today

A historic former school building in the heart of Merizo once used as a village youth center, has been boarded up for years and has become a target for vendors.

Officials are working on a grant from the Guam Preservation Trust, which spent \$500,000 to repair the building in 1997, to repair the Merizos G. Cook School, and lawmakers today will hear public testimony on a bill that would transfer the school from the Department of Parks and Recreation to the village mayor's office.

The basketball court next to the Cook School is popular with village youth, said 50-year-old Merizo resident Jessica Santiago. There aren't many other recreational activities, she said, and it would be a good idea to have pool tables or other activities at the Cook School. Santiago said many of the older residents in the village have a connection to the building because they went to school there, and using the facility regularly would help keep it maintained.

Former Mayor Ignacio "Buck" Cruz, who was a student at the Cook School, said typhoons damaged the building several years ago, then rock-throwing youths broke more windows and damaged it further.

Most of the windows in the

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SIXTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$16,000.00) FROM THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF VICE SPEAKER JOANNE M.S. BROWN AND TO AUTHORIZE THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM TO REAPPROPRIATE THE UNEXPENDED FUNDS FROM SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 28-17 TO THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM'S INARAJAN AGRICULTURAL EXPERIMENT STATION TO PURCHASE A TOTAL CARBON/NITROGEN ANALYZER AND RELATED SUPPLIES.

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslatura* finds that  
3 Public Law No. 28-17, deappropriated Fifty-Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) from  
4 the Office of Vice Speaker Joanne M.S. Brown to the University of Guam for  
5 the purchase of a Compost Turner and needed supplies to begin composting  
6 operations at the University of Guam's Inarajan Agricultural Experiment  
7 Station. The intent of the P.L. 28-17 was to help the community realize the  
8 benefits of composting biodegradable waste, utilizing the technical expertise  
9 available at the university. This will provide a responsible alternative for the

1 island to reduce the high volume of trash generated on Guam daily, and  
2 divert the waste stream from the overcrowded landfill.

3 *I Liheslatura* also finds that the university needs further monetary  
4 assistance in purchasing equipment, specifically, a Total Carbon/Total  
5 Nitrogen Analyzer, an instrument that will ensure that the compost product is  
6 at its optimum quality, and more importantly, that it is safe before it is  
7 applied to the environment.

8 **Section 2. Deappropriation and Reappropriation.** The sum of Sixteen  
9 Thousand Dollars (\$16,000.00) is hereby deappropriated from the sums  
10 appropriated to *I Liheslatura* and reappropriated to the University of Guam's  
11 Inarajan Agricultural Experiment Station for the *sole* purpose of purchasing a  
12 Total Carbon/Nitrogen Analyzer and supplies needed for its operations.  
13 Notwithstanding any other law or rule, the Fiscal Officer of *I Liheslatura* is

16 **Section 3. Reappropriation of the unexpended sums of Section 2 of**

18 reappropriate the unexpended fund from Section 2 of Public Law 28-17 for the  
19 *sole* purpose of a Total Carbon/Nitrogen Analyzer.

20 **Section 4. Reporting.** One hundred and eighty (180) days after the  
21 enactment of this Act, the University of Guam's Inarajan Agricultural  
22 Experiment Station shall prepare financial reports on the expenditure of this  
23 appropriation for the President of the University of Guam, who shall then
