Footnotes: The proposed bill entails a fiscal impact on the Healthy Future's Fund by an amount of \$155,262 for the purpose of procuring new hardware and software to upgrade and update the Absent Parent Automated System Information (APASI) system. The proposed amount represents 34% in local matching funds from a total cost of \$456,654, as estimated to meet the intent of the proposed legislation. The 66% federal share totals \$301,392 which will be funded under the Child Support Enforcement Program. Please note that based on the Fund Balance of September 30, 2003, 2004 & 2005 for the Healthy Futures Fund, the Unreserved Fund Balance indicates a deficit of \$931,756.

Calvo, Senator Ray Tenorio, author of Bill No. 243 (EC), briefly explained that Office of the Attorney General of Guam is requesting assistance from the Legislature to purchase new hardware and software equipment for its Absent Parent Automated System Information (APASI) program. The local appropriation, if made, will cover the remaining one third (1/3) of the total purchase cost for the new equipment, with the remaining two thirds (2/3) covered by the federal government. Senator Tenorio concluded his remarks highlighting the importance of preventing any loss of valuable information relative to the maintenance of child support records and organized check-distribution computer programs.

This public hearing was adjourned at 3:03 p.m. Chairman Calvo informed the Committee that a roundtable meeting would be scheduled to allow for a continuation of discussion by representatives from the Office of the Attorney General and as well as to receive any additional testimony from the public concerning Bill No. 243 (LS).

In accordance with public notice requirements, the Committee held a roundtable meeting on Friday, February 10, 2006, 10:29 a.m. at *I Liheslaturan Guåhan's* Public Hearing Room in *Hagåtña*.

Mrs. Barbara Cepeda, Deputy Attorney General for the Child Support Division, Office of the Attorney General of Guam, along with other representatives from her office, was present to present additional testimony relative to Bill No. 243 (LS). According to Mrs. Cepeda, the computer system in her division is approximately ten (10) years old and is approaching a state of malfunction. Mrs. Cepeda reiterated statements made by the bill's author, Senator Ray Tenorio, regarding the need for the local government to take

advantage of funding only one third (1/3) of the total cost for the new computer programs, with the federal government covering the remaining two thirds (2/3). The Deputy Attorney General shared comments recognizing the importance of preventing a complete systems failure, which would jeopardize the division's ability to continue collecting approximately one million dollars as well as issuing a total of five thousand (5,000) checks on a monthly basis.

Following general statements from panel members echoing the importance of maintaining a viable computer system within the Child Support Office, Chairman Calvo informed and encouraged members of the public that his Committee will continue to accept written testimonies at his office within ten (10) working days following today's meeting. The Chairman concluded this public hearing at 10:53 a.m.

III. COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Committee finds that the child support computer system, also known as Absent Parent Automated System Information (APASI) program, used by the Office of the Attorney General has not been upgraded or updated since 1996. The Child Support Enforcement Division (CSED) uses the same system to perform certain tasks such as license suspension, passport denial, and automated income withholding. The current hardware and software being utilized by the APASI system is outdated and continues to be a risk for the maintenance and operation of the system.

Covansys, the prime vendor contracted to maintain and operate the APASI system, has indicated several issues and risks related to the APASI hardware, system software, network and infrastructure components that require immediate mitigation. The potential impact, should the system fail, freeze or crash, would be an unrecoverable system, loss of data, exposure and accessibility of confidential information. CSED personnel will resort to manual processing of information which will delay, at the very least, compilation of data required for court hearings and child support payments. The

Committee further recognizes the health and safety interests of those children who depend of support checks for their food, clothing, and housing necessities.

The Committee, therefore, recommends that *I Liheslatura* provide the necessary funding to the Office of the Attorney General to upgrade the APASI system in order to stabilize the Child Support Division's network system and to avoid the risk of a complete systems failure.

This is a follow-up to today's roundtable discussion of Bill 243 to appropriate \$155,262 to the Attorney General's Office for the purpose of procuring new hardware and software to upgrade the child support computer system. At that discussion, you mentioned that your staff found that the Attorney General's Office has about \$731,000 in lapses from previous years.

I met with Terry Ascura, Acting Chief of Administration to discuss this issue and she informs me that the Attorney General's Office has numerous pending GG-1's at the Department of Administration. Per the Budget Law authorization, the funds are committed to hiring new prosecutors. Based on these projections, we anticipate that we will exhaust current funding as well the \$731,000 in lapses.

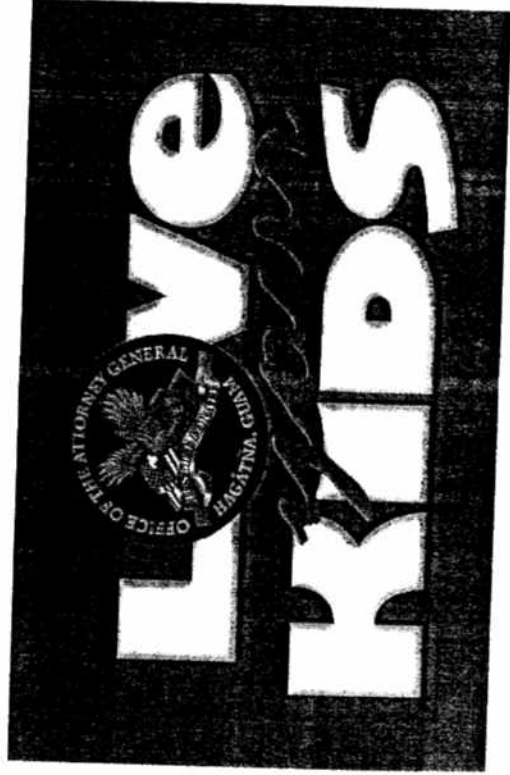

Introduction

- APASI is the software used to collect and disburse Child Support payments.
- APASI interfaces with different agencies (SSA, Rev&Tax, Superior Court) to share data with regard to Child Support Enforcement.
- APASI handles about 15,000 active Child Support cases in Guam.

History of APASI



- APASI hardware and software was procured during the mid 90's by Accenture and Chase Global Services.
- APASI was fully implemented in August 1996.
- Since 1996, APASI hardware and software has not been upgraded.
- Our current APASI software version lost support from its vendor, Software AG since 2000.



Major Technical Risks

- Outdated Hardware = Increased risk of failure and decreased performance.
- Outdated Software version = Application failure and impacts data integrity.
- Outdated Hardware and Software = no current technical support and limited or no recovery options should they fail.



Major Technical Issues

- Database shuts down several times a day causing loss of productivity.
- Growing database and number of users requires more disk space and user licenses.
- Current system cannot handle the growing caseload efficiently.
- The Child Support Office currently is using Sun Solaris v2.6 which is no longer supported. The latest version is Sun Solaris 10.
- Recent and pending hardware failure. Obsolete hardware parts are difficult to find and costs more than new ones.

Should APASI fail...



- System downtime
 - Estimated system downtime could range from 2 weeks to 6 months.
- There will be Interruption of benefits
 - Child Support Checks will be delayed.
 - Electronic File transfers can't be processed.
 - Kids First Card payments have to be manually prepared.
 - Wage deductions received from Employers cannot be processed.
- Delays on Legal Action
 - Court preparation for Child Support cases will be delayed.
 - Court processing will come to a halt.
 - Case tracking will be limited.
 - New cases can't be enforced.

Should APASI fail...



- Processing with no automation
 - Processing will be done manually.
 - Federally required functions will not be processed, such as Passport Denial, License suspension, Tax Intercepts, FIDM, Automated Wage Withholding etc.
 - Staffing requirements will dramatically change
 - Enforcement will be impacted.
- Staff productivity affected
 - Cases requiring immediate attention will add to the backlog of issues and cases.
- Estimated cost impact
 - Based on loss of worker productivity, manual intervention, system unavailability and overhead the operational cost is estimated at \$400,000 to \$800,000 for the downtime, not to include costs to install a new system.

Disaster Recovery



- Time
 - Recovery period can take anywhere from 2 weeks to 6 months.
 - After working hours needs to be utilized.
- Resources
 - Covansys will have to reassign all project staff to handle technical issues. This will affect the current level of software support.
 - CSED will call for a major reorganization of staff to address the disaster.
- Data Issues
 - Manually processed data during the downtime will have to be entered in the system.
 - Migration of data from the old system has to be done after working hours to ensure data integrity.



Summary

- APASI system is antiquated and has not been upgraded for almost 10 years.
- Upgrading the APASI system is a preventive measure to avoid a potential catastrophic failure.
- Upgraded APASI system will allow for better performance and innovative enhancements to serve the Child Support mission.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY-TWO DOLLARS (\$155,262.00) FROM THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND TO THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL FOR THE LOCAL MATCHING REQUIREMENTS OF FEDERAL FUNDING AWARDED FOR THE SOLE PURPOSE OF PROCURING NEW HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE TO UPGRADE THE CHILD SUPPORT COMPUTER SYSTEM AKA ABSENT PARENT AUTOMATED SYSTEM INFORMATION (APASI).

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. **Legislative Intent and Findings.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that
3 the child support computer system also known as Absent Parent Automated System
4 Information (APASI) used by the Office of the Attorney General has not been
5 upgraded or updated since 1996. The Child Support Enforcement Division (CSED)
6 uses the system to perform certain tasks such as license suspension, passport denial,
7 and automated income withholding. The current hardware and software being
8 utilized by the APASI system is outdated and continues to be a risk for the
9 maintenance and operation of the system.

10 Covansys, the prime vendor contracted to maintain and operate the APASI
11 system, has indicated several issues and risks related to the APASI hardware,
12 system software, network and infrastructure components that require immediate
13 mitigation. The potential impact, should the system fail, freeze or crash, would be

1 an unrecoverable system, loss of data, exposure and accessibility of confidential
2 information. CSED personnel will resort to manual processing of information which
3 will delay, at the very least, compilation of data required for court hearings and
4 child support payments. Every child depends on these checks for their food,
5 clothing and shelter.

6 Therefore, it is the intent of the *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to provide the necessary
7 funding to the Office of the Attorney General to upgrade the APASI system to
8 stabilize the network system and avoid the risk of a breakdown.

9 **Section 2.** One Hundred Fifty-five Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-two
10 Dollars (\$155,262.00) is hereby appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund to the
11 Office of the Attorney General for the sole purpose of procuring new hardware and
12 software to upgrade and update the APASI system.
