### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that studies have shown that the best deterrent for drugs and alcohol among our youth is being active in sports. In many of our villages the public facilities have been in disrepair because of lack of maintenance and/or acts of God and are in need of major improvements to provide the various sports programs offered by the mayors.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the municipality of Agat has 9 tennis and basketball courts that have not been in use for many years and 10 should be repaired for the benefit of the residents.

11 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate 12 Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) to the Office of the Agat 13 Mayor for the repair and resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts.

Section 2. Deappropriation and Reappropriation. The sum of 14 Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby deappropriated from 15 the sums appropriated to I Liheslaturan Guåhan for Fiscal Year 2006 and 16 reappropriated to the Office of the Agat Mayor for the repair and resurfacing 17 of the tennis and basketball courts. Notwithstanding any other law or rule, 18 the Fiscal Officer of I Liheslaturan Guåhan shall reduce the budget 19 20 allotment to Senator Lou Leon Guerrero for Fiscal Year 2006 by an amount equal to the sum deappropriated by this Section and transfer that sum to the 21 Department of Administration for expenditure in accordance herewith. 22

23 Section 3. Reporting. Within sixty (60) days after the end of Fiscal 24 Year 2006, the Agat Mayor shall submit a written report regarding the 25 expenditure of this appropriation to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. *No* portion of 26 this appropriation shall be used for purposes other than that specifically 27 defined in Section 2 of this Act.





### I. OVERVIEW

The Executive Committee held a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on March 8, 2006 in the Session Hall, I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Public notice was given to all media (see facsimile confirmation page) on March 1 and March 6, 2006. Notice was placed in the PDN on March 6, 2006.

### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Individuals that appeared before the Committee to present oral and written testimony on the bill were as follows:

**Mayor Carol Tayama**, oral and written testimony in support of Bill No. 262. Mayor Tayama gave brief testimony in which she described the physical condition of the tennis and basketball courts. She thanked the Author of Bill No. 262, Senator Lou Leon Guerrero for providing the funding assistance from her office in the refurbishment of the basketball and tennis courts in the village. ### III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Executive Committee finds that the intent of Bill No. 262 will deappropriate money allocated to Senator Lou Leon Guerrero and be reappropriated to the Office of the Agat Mayor for the purpose of resurface and repairs of the Tennis and Basketball courts in the village.







At the present time our gym is fully utilized by several schools in the area, namely Oceanview Middle, Southern High and Mt. Carmel School because they lack a gym facility. The Oceanview Middle School and Southern High School gym have been condemned and we have been assisting them. They practice at our gym and play their games at our gym.

Many times our youths in the Community are without a court. By repairing our outdoor courts our youths will definitely have an alternate place to go to when our gym is being used.

Once again I thank you for this opportunity and I hope you will vote in favor of the bill.

### MINA'BENTE OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUAHAN 2006 (Second) Regular Session

Bill No. 262 (EC)

Introduced by:

L.A. Leon Guerrero M. Forbes

AN ACT TO DEAPPROPRIATE TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000.00) FROM THE SUMS APPROPRIATED TO THE *I LIHESLATURA GUAHAN* FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006 AND TO REAPPROPRIATE SAID SUM TO THE OFFICE OF AGAT MAYOR FOR THE REPAIR AND RESURFACING OF THE TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURTS.

### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** The *Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that studies have shown that the best deterrent for drugs and alcohol among our youth are being active in sports. In many of our villages, the public facilities have been in disrepair because of lack of maintenance and/or acts of God and are in need of major improvements to provide the various sports programs being offered by the mayors.

The *Liheslaturan Guahan* further finds that the municipality of Agat have tennis and basketball courts that have not been in use for many years and should be repaired for the residents, especially the youth to promote a healthy, drug free lifestyle that includes exercise.

Therefore, it is the intent of the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to deappropriate twentyfive thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) to the Office of the Agat Mayor for the repair and resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts.

**Section 2. Deappropriation and Reappropriation.** The sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) is hereby deappropriated from the sums appropriated to the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* for Fiscal Year 2006 and reappropriated to the Office of the Agat Mayor for the repair and resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts. Notwithstanding of any other law or rule, the Fiscal Officer of the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* shall reduce the budget allotment to Senator Lou Leon Guerrero for Fiscal Year 2006 by an amount equal to the sum deappropriated by this Section and transfer that sum to the Department of Administration for expenditure in accordance herewith.

**Section 3. Reporting**. Within sixty (60) days after the end of Fiscal Years 2006, the Office of the Agat Mayor shall submit a written report regarding the expenditure of this appropriation to the *I Liheslaturan Guahan*. No portion of this appropriation shall be used for purposes other than that specifically defined in Section 2 of this Act.

Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
