6 Chapter 8, §8122(b) for Tax Exempt Commercial Paper from its current limit of
7 \$30,000,000 to \$40,000,000.

8 **Section 2. 12 GCA, Chapter 8, §8122(b)** is amended to read:

9 (b) Purposes: Terms of Borrowing, GPA is Authorized to Incur Debt Under the Tax
10 Exempt Commercial Paper Program Up to a Limit of Forty Million Dollars (\$40,000,000).
11 This amount may be used to replace the existing lines of credit. At no time will the total
12 outstanding balance borrowed from TCEP and lines of credit arising from operation and
13 maintenance purposes exceed this amount without approval from the Public Utilities
14 Commission.

15 **Section 3. Severability.** *If* any provisions of this Act or its application to any
16 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall *not*
17 affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect without the
18 invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
