

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes the important role that recreational and sports activities for the youth of Guam play in minimizing juvenile delinquency.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the old basketball and tennis courts in the municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago are public recreational facilities that have been neglected and abandoned for almost a decade, and should be restored to usable condition. Estimates for the repair of both courts is Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000).

I Liheslaturan Guåhan also finds that the previous appropriation of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to the Mayor of Ordot-Chalan Pago, which was included in the Miscellaneous Appropriation provisions of the Fiscal Year 1995 Budget Act, was never released by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research for implementation.

It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to re-emphasize the importance of this project by appropriating the necessary funding for the repair of the tennis and basketball courts in the municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago so the youth of the village can also avail themselves of much needed recreational facilities.

Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Ordot-Chalan Pago Mayor for the repair and resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts in the municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago.

The Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, January 25, 2006, 9:40 a.m. at I Liheslaturan Guahan's Public Hearing Room on Bill No. 235 (EC), "An Act To Appropriate The Sum Of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars From The General Fund To The Office Of The Ordot-Chalan Pago Mayor For The Repair And Resurfacing Of The Tennis And Basketball Courts". II. SUMMARY OF VERBAL TESTIMONIES:

Following introductory remarks by Chairman Edward J.B. Calvo, Senator Adolpho Palacios, author of Bill No. 235 (EC), briefly discussed the non-dispersal of a \$250,000 appropriation in the Fiscal Year 1995 Budget Law by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research to the Municipality of Chalan Pago-Ordot Mayor's Office to fund the resurfacing of its dilapidated tennis and basketball courts and for other purposes. The proposed measure would satisfy the unfulfilled mandate that was approved over a decade ago and will help the community of Chalan Pago-Ordot by offering functional sports facilities available within the district.

Mayor Pedro Borja from the Municipality of Chalan Pago-Ordot provided written and verbal testimony in support of Bill No. 235 (EC). In addition to requesting for the appropriate funds that should have been dispersed to his district since 1995, Mayor Borja explained that although the proposed measure does not include the repair and renovation of restroom facilities, an attachment for review by panel members with estimates indicating that the \$75,000, as requested, is sufficient to include such additional repairs. The mayor concluded by requesting that Bill No. 235 (EC) be amended to include repairs to the restroom facilities. (Complete text attached)

Following comments made by the aforementioned individuals, Senator Ray Tenorio echoed the sentiments of Senator Palacios and recommended that the District of Chalan Pago-Ordot consider establishing a public-private partnership with members of Guam's business community. Senator Tenorio explained that this approach would help prevent unfunded mandates that essentially give false hope to those who are anticipating financial help from the executive and legislative branches.

Vice-Chairman Larry Kasperbauer and Senator Judith Won Pat concluded with brief remarks concerning the importance of recreational facilities intended to help offer alternative sources of activity for Guam's youth.

Chairman Edward J.B. Calvo concluded by extending his appreciation to those in attendance for presenting their testimony on Bill No. 235 (EC). The Chairman informed the public that an additional ten (10) working days is provided for individuals wanting to submit written testimony on said legislation and subsequently adjourned this Public Hearing of the Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce at 12:20 p.m.

III. COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce finds that both the legislative and executive branches of the Government of Guam approved an appropriation of \$250,000 in the Fiscal Year 1995 Budget Law for the repair of the tennis and basketball courts and for other purposes in the Municipality of Chalan Pago-Ordot. The Committee further finds that that the old basketball and tennis courts in the Municipality of Chalan Pago-Ordot are public recreational facilities that have been neglected and abandoned for almost a decade, and should be restored to usable condition. The Committee, therefore, recommends that *I Liheslatura* re-emphasize the importance of this project by appropriating the necessary funding for the repair of the aforementioned sports facilities in said district so the youth of the village can also avail themselves of much needed recreational facilities.

Dear Senator Calvo:

I submit this as my testimony in favor of Bill No. 235 and to reiterate the urgent need to appropriate the requested \$75,000 to resurface the dilapidated tennis and basketball courts in the municipality of Chalan Pago-Ordot.

As mentioned in Bill No. 235, an appropriation of \$100,000 was originally included in the budget law of FY 1995, but the appropriation was never released by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research (BBMR). Consequently, these two sports facilities remained unutilized and their dilapidated conditions even worsened. Needless to say, the youth of Chalan Pago-Ordot did not have a place to play tennis and basketball for the past ten long years.

In response to your request for budgetary information, please be informed that the funding for personnel, utilities and supplies are practically the same in FY 2006. In contrast, the operational budget was reduced from \$20,000 to \$4,062. However, in FY 2006, we received the following appropriations from three special funds: Healthy Futures Fund - \$20,000; Tourist Attraction Fund - \$33,267; Village Street Fund - \$76,000.

Indeed, we appreciate the appropriation from the Healthy Futures Fund to implement planned adult education courses and seminars. Likewise, the monies from the Tourist Attraction Fund are long-awaited for village-wide beautification projects. Finally, the appropriation from the Village Street Fund will be utilized by our maintenance staff for equipment and supplies to upkeep secondary and tertiary roads.

Although the intended purpose of Bill No. 235 does not include the repair and renovation of the restroom facilities, the attached estimates obtained indicate the \$75,000 requested is sufficient to include the repair and renovation of the restroom facilities. Therefore, I am requesting to amend the intended purpose of the Bill to include the restroom facilities.

In conclusion, we cannot over-emphasize the dire need for the appropriation of \$75,000 for the resurfacing and overall renovation, including lighting, of the tennis and basketball courts, to include the restroom facilities. If funding is no longer available in the General Fund, perhaps the Healthy Futures Fund or other appropriate special funds can be looked at as an alternative source.

My name is Janel Borja, and I live in Chalan Pago. I have played tennis competitively and recreationally for the past six years. In that amount of time, I have come to know the difficulties of finding a court to play on. There are three public courts that are currently open right now. Those are the public courts in Hagatna, Tamuning, and Tyan. The other courts are private, in which you have to pay for membership to the hotel, such as Hilton, Ladera, or Pacific Islands Club. Because of the limitation of public courts, there are few options for citizens to get court time.

I am in support of Bill No. 235- To appropriate \$75,000 to repair and renovate the tennis and basketball courts at the ball field in Chalan Pago because tennis is an excellent recreational sport for youth. I live right across from the community center here in Chalan Pago, and I see the activities that happen there. I notice people just walking around to get a work out, or games being played in the field, but the old basketball court is used for cock-fighting. I think it would be put to better use if it was a basketball court or a tennis court so that the youth in our village would have a place to go and play. It would be an excellent place for youth to express themselves, get a good work out, and have fun right in their own village.

Written Testimony for Bill 235

The Prevention and Training Branch of the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, using data from the State Epidemiological Workgroup, is available to provide evidence-based recommendations to the community from local data and statistics.

Obesity is a major healthcare concern among Guam's children.

Several indicators found in the 2003 Guam Youth Risk Behavior Survey (YRBS) highlight obesity as a problem amongst our island's youth:

- 84% of high school students are at risk for becoming overweight;
- 62% of students did not play on one or more sports teams during the past 12 months; and
- 84% of students participated in no vigorous or moderate physical activity during the past seven days.

These facts are alarming and imply that majority of high school children on Guam are at high risk of obesity. Our population's predisposition to diabetes, and the prevalence of other compounding health risk factors such as smoking and alcohol use, make interventions to reduce obesity and to promote healthier lifestyles a critical priority among our youth.

The US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) have identified inadequate physical activity and increased inactivity as key factors related to the onset of activity. The lack of good sports facilities for Guam's children is a major contributing factor to physical inactivity. Access to sports facilities encourages exercise, and, within the appropriate framework, can be a major factor for reducing tobacco, alcohol and drug use among youth. In fact, the United Nations encourages the use of sports as a drug prevention program.

For these reasons, Bill No. 235 can be viewed not only as a community improvement measure but also as an intervention to promote healthier lifestyles among Guam's children by encouraging increased physical activity, reducing the risk of obesity and its health-related consequences, and providing a healthy alternative to tobacco, alcohol and drug use.

At this time, I would like to suggest two major changes to Bill 235, as I originally introduced:

- 1) I am suggesting that the source of the \$75,000 funding appropriation be switched to the Healthy Futures Fund instead of the General Fund. The continuing collection of increased excise tax on alcohol and cigarette renders the availability of the funds more dependable.
- 2) The \$75,000 appropriation requested in Bill 235 is sufficient to fund the resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts at \$50,000, and the renovation and refurbishing of the restroom facilities at \$25,000. May I request the Committee to amend Bill 235 to reflect this change accordingly. Otherwise, I can easily submit a substitute bill.

In closing, may I reiterate my plea for an expeditious and favorable action on Bill 235, on behalf of the Mayor of Ordot-Chalan Pago and all the residents of that municipality, especially the youth who will be utilizing these much needed facilities. Thank you so much.

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE OFFICE OF THE ORDOT-CHALAN PAGO MAYOR FOR THE REPAIR AND RESURFACING OF THE TENNIS AND BASKETBALL COURTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan recognizes the important role that recreational and sports activities for the youth of Guam play in minimizing juvenile delinquency.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the old basketball and tennis courts in the municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago are public recreational facilities that have been neglected and abandoned for almost a decade, and should be restored to usable condition. Estimates for the repair of both courts is Seventy Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000).

I Liheslaturan Guåhan also finds that the previous appropriation of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000) to the Mayor of Ordot-Chalan Pago, which was included in the Miscellaneous Appropriation provisions of the Fiscal Year 1995 Budget Act, was never released by the Bureau of Budget and Management Research for implementation.

It is therefore the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to re-emphasize the importance of this project by appropriating the necessary funding for the repair of the tennis and basketball courts in the municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago so the youth of the village can also avail themselves of much needed recreational facilities.

Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Ordot-Chalan Pago Mayor for the repair and resurfacing of the tennis and basketball courts in the municipality of Ordot-Chalan Pago.
