1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Guam Community College has been very instrumental in providing

1 support to the medical profession by graduating about one hundred (100) students
2 a year in their Allied Health Program. Students can graduate from the Allied
3 Health Program and receive an Associate of Science (AS) Degree and become a
4 Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Practical Nurse (PN), Nursing Assistant (NA) or a
5 Medical Assistant (MA). The student can use this degree as a step ladder to move
6 towards a Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN) at the University of Guam.

7 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate Forty Thousand
8 Dollars (\$40,000.00) to the Guam Community College for the *sole* purpose of
9 supporting the Allied Health Program, specifically the Licensed Practical Nurse
10 (LPN), Practical Nursing (PN), Nursing Assistant (NA) and Medical Assistant
11 (MA) Programs by purchasing equipment and supplies for students in their
12 teaching/learning laboratory.

13 **Section 2. De-appropriation and Reappropriation.** The sum of Forty
14 Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) is hereby de-appropriated from the sums
15 appropriated to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for Fiscal Year 2006 and reappropriated to
16 the Guam Community College for the *sole* purpose of purchasing supplies and
17 equipment for the Allied Health Program, specifically the Licensed Practical
18 Nursing, Practical Nursing, Nursing Assistant and Medical Assistant Programs.
19 Notwithstanding any other law or rule, the Fiscal Officer of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
20 shall reduce the budget allotment to Senator Lou Leon Guerrero for Fiscal Year
21 2006 by an amount equal to the sum de-appropriated by this Section and transfer
22 that sum to the Department of Administration for expenditure in accordance
23 herewith.

24 **Section 3. Reporting.** Within sixty (60) days after the end of Fiscal Year
25 2006, the Guam Community College shall submit a written report regarding the
26 expenditure of this appropriation to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. No portion of this






BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guahan* finds that the Guam Community College has been very instrumental in providing support to the medical profession by graduating about 100 students a year in their Allied Health Program. Students can graduate from the Allied Health Program and receive an Associate of Science (AS) Degree and become a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Practical Nurse (PN), Nursing Assistant (NA) or a Medical Assistant (MA). These are critical positions in both the Government of Guam and the private sector to ensure that all patients receive the best medical care possible. In addition, after receiving an AS Degree, the student can use this as a step ladder to move towards a Bachelors of Science in Nursing (BSN) at the University of Guam.

As the critical shortage for medical professionals continue to escalate on Guam and the nation, it is crucial that we support all programs and students who wish to enter into the medical field.

It is the intent of the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to deappropriate forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00) to the Guam Community College for the sole purpose of supporting the Allied Health Program, specifically the Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Practical

Nursing (PA), Nursing Assistant (NA) and Medical Assistant (MA) Programs by purchasing equipment and supplies for students in their teaching/learning laboratory.

Section 2. Deappropriation and Reappropriation. The sum of Forty Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00) is hereby deappropriated from the sums appropriated to the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* for Fiscal Year 2006 and reappropriated to the Guam Community College for the *sole* purpose of purchasing supplies and equipment the for Allied Health Program, specifically the Practical Nursing, Nursing Assistant, Medical Assistant Programs. Notwithstanding any other law or rule, the Fiscal Officer of the *I Liheslaturan Guahan* shall reduce the budget allotment to Senator Lou Leon Guerrero for Fiscal Year 2006 by an amount equal to the sum deappropriated by this Section and transfer that sum to the Department of Administration for expenditure in accordance herewith.

Section 3. Reporting. Section 4. I. OVERVIEW

The Executive Committee held a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on March 29, 2006 in the Session Hall, I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Public notice was given to all media (see facsimile confirmation page) on March 22 and March 27, 2006.

Senators present at the public hearing were:

Speaker Mark Forbes, Chairman
Senator Lou Leon Guerrero

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Individuals that appeared before the Committee to present oral and written testimony on the bill were as follows:

Ms. Mary Okada, Vice President of Business and Finance, Guam Community College provided written testimony in support of Bill No. 264. She said "the Guam Community College included the LPN program as part of the growth budget presented to the legislature. This inclusion of this funding in our FY 2006 budget approval was the first step in growing the programs at the college in response to the needs of our community. GCC continues to be committed to addressing the needs of our community". She was supported by Ms. Lois Gage, Director, Practical Nursing Program and Mr. Reilly Ridgell, Dean of Trades & Professional Services, who were also present at the public hearing.

Discussion:

Senator Lou Leon Guerrero, Author of Bill No. 264 (EC) provided brief remarks on her bill. Senator Leon Guerrero said that she is pleased to have present the Director of the Allied Health Program at the Guam Community College at the public hearing today. She said the LPN's are like the hands, feet and ears of the nurses. The Allied Health Program at GCC graduates about 100 students a year in this program and the funding will go into the program's laboratory to provide for the purchase of teaching tools and equipment. She said the recent leadership summit has addressed the issue of a critical shortage of nurses on our island and by providing additional funding to the program will allow the students to further develop their learning skills in the laboratory.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Executive Committee finds that the intent of Bill No. 264 will allow the Guam Community College's Allied Health Program to purchase needed supplies and equipment for their learning laboratory from funding deappropriated from the budget allocated to Senator Lou Leon Guerrero. The reappropriated amount of \$40,000 to GCC will be used for the specific purpose of assisting the Allied Health Program.
