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

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

Bill 244 summary of testimony:

- **David Sullivan** provided oral testimony in his personal capacity in support of Bill 244 (EC). Mr. Sullivan expressed appreciation for the legislation and his belief that it will "plug a hole in the system in a balanced and judicious way."
- Robert Camacho, director of Corrections, presented oral testimony in support of Bill 244 (EC). As director he explained instances where DEPCOR employees were arrested for various crimes and did not provide notice. Directors find themselves unable to administer discipline in accordance with the 60-day rule in these circumstances due to delayed notice of the charge or conviction. He believes Bill 244 provides an avenue for dealing with such cases. Mr. Camacho also recommended background checks at the federal level and control measures to terminate employees charged with a felony and pleading down to a misdemeanor.

Bill 244 findings & recommendations:

Current Guam law does not provide a means to insure that charges or convictions of government of Guam employees are reported to an employee's department or agency head.

Due to this deficiency department and agency heads have been unable to assess the need for disciplinary actions in a timely fashion. The result has been many instances of undiscovered misconduct that has hindered government operations and the safety of the work environment for other employees.

The committee finds that Bill 244 remedies this problem by closing the loophole. With the proposed legislation, employees will be required by law to provide prompt notice of criminal charges or convictions to the department or agency head. The failure to do is grounds for separate adverse action and allows the 60-day rule defined in Title 4 G.C.A. § 4406 to commence upon the notice of the employee's charge or conviction to the department or agency head.

Accordingly, the Committee on Judiciary, Government Operations, & Reorganization, does hereby submit its findings and recommendation to *DO PASS* Bill 244 (EC), AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 4202.1, 4202.2 TO TITLE 4 G.C.A. TO REQUIRE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CHARGED WITH OR CONVICTED OF A CRIME TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE NOTICE OF THE CHARGES OR CONVICTION TO THE HEAD OF THE EMPLOYEE'S DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY AND TO PROVIDE SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE NOTICE.

TO REQUIRE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CHARGED WITH OR CONVICTED OF A CRIME TO PROVIDE IMMEDIATE NOTICE OF THE CHARGES OR CONVICTION TO THE HEAD OF THE EMPLOYEE'S DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY AND TO PROVIDE SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE NOTICE

I submit this testimony in support of Bill 244. As Director of Corrections, I have encountered incidences involving Corrections employees in the past being arrested for various crimes without notice to the Director. The 60 day rule regarding actions against employees had long since past and as the present Director I was unable to take action on these cases. Some cases involved probationary time for serious offenses. This Bill is essential for us to ensure that our employees are following the laws in which they are sworn to uphold. The stipulation that they must also inform the Director of any probationary time, fines, or even dismissals should be mandatory.

I would also like to mention that the background checks should also include at the federal level to ensure that any employee hired from off-island does not fall under the radar of our scrutiny. I must also note that maybe there should be control measures that if an employee is charged with a felony but yet pleas down to a misdemeanor, termination should be available as an option.
