Subject: Health Hazards at the old Piti Mayor's Office

Senator Won-Pat Borja,

Thef ollowing is a letter I sent to Governor Camacho on October 31, 2005 regarding the <u>health hazards</u> I was facing within my old office. This is therefore the reason I am requesting the rent money for my current office space.

Friday, October 21, 2005 Governor Camacho,

Here at the Piti Mayor's Office we are experiencing a serious problem that I feel needs your immediate attention.

After I was elected back in January 2005, my office was located at 260 Assumption Drive in Piti. During that first month, both toilets in the building would sometimes overflow with raw sewage. By March, this overflowing would occur as often as five times a week. Since this was a serious **health hazard**, I decided to move my office to 306 Assumption Drive in Piti.

In an attempt to fix the problem we notified the Guam Waterworks Authority. GWA assessed the situation and notified us that the problem was not the sewer line, but the location of the office itself. The floor of the office and all the sewer lines leading out are actually lower in the ground in reference to the main sewer line going through the village. Because of this lower proximity, the toilets will always overflow. The only suggestion GWA made was to build a second floor on the building and place the bathrooms upstairs. Since this was not an option we could take, we have been using our current office (rent free) since March.

The former Mayor of Piti, Isabel Haggard, was renting this space for \$1,400/mo. The contract I have received for rent is \$1,000/mo. This is why I am formally requesting that you appropriate \$12,000 for the Piti Mayor's Office for Fiscal Year 2006.

Despite lobbying with the Legislature, the language for Piti office rental was not included within the budget bill for FY 2006. I humbly ask that you approve my request as soon as possible. Thank you for your time and consideration.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative findings and intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Mayor of Piti has been graciously allowed to utilize, on a temporary basis, property owned by the Piti Catholic Church at no cost. However, the Mayor of Piti has been advised that the Piti Catholic Church needs the space for its own use, thereby necessitating the need for rental appropriation.

Therefore, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to provide the necessary funding for office space rent for the Mayor of Piti.

Section 2. Appropriation. The sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Office of the Mayor of Piti for the sole purpose of office rental in Fiscal Year 2006.

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce held a Public Hearing on Wednesday, January 25, 2006, 9:40 a.m. at *I Liheslaturan Guahan's* Public Hearing Room on Bill No. 236 (EC), "An Act To Appropriate Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) For The Rental Of Office Space In Fiscal Year 2006 For The Mayor's Office Of Piti". Notices of this public hearing were disseminated throughout all local media via facsimile and are attached herein.

II. SUMMARY OF VERBAL TESTIMONIES:

Following introductory remarks by Chairman Edward J.B. Calvo, Senator Adolpho Palacios, author of Bill No. 236 (EC), briefly discussed the issue of inadequate office space for the Piti Mayor's Office. Senator Palacios informed the Committee and members of the public that the amendment provided in Public Law 28-81, Section 4, authorized, but did not appropriate, the amount of \$12,000 from the Mayors' Council of Guam's Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund Appropriations to the Piti Mayor's Office for rent payments for the current fiscal year. Senator Palacios encouraged members of the Committee to report Bill No. 236 (EC) for immediate consideration by the full legislature.

Mr. Karl Cepeda, Administrative Assistant for the Piti Mayor's Office, read the written testimony of the Honorable Vicente Gumataotao, who was at the time of this public hearing under medical care. According to Mayor Gumataotao's testimony, the Mayors' Council of Guam held a meeting regarding P.L. 28-81 and decided that said law "did not" mandate the Council to allocate \$12,000 for the rental of office space by the Piti Mayor's Office.

With no further comments, Chairman Edward J.B. Calvo informed members of the public that the Committee will review the appropriations made by the legislature to the Mayors' Council of Guam, particularly the additional funds allocated in FY 2006 in consideration of issues such as the rental needs of various mayoral offices throughout the island.

Chairman Calvo concluded by extending his appreciation to those in attendance for presenting their testimony on Bill No. 236 (EC). The Chairman informed the public that an additional ten (10) working days is provided for individuals wanting to submit written testimony on said legislation and subsequently adjourned this Public Hearing of the Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce.

III. COMMITTEE FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce finds that the amount of \$12,000 was never transferred from the Mayors' Council of Guam's Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund Appropriations to the Piti Mayor's Office pursuant to an authorization provided in Public Law 28-81, Section 4. The Committee intends to provide legislative clarification through a substitute version of Bill No. 236 (EC), and further recommends that *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* provide such necessary funding, through Section 24 (d), Chapter IV, of Public Law 27-29, "General Appropriations Act of 2004", for the rental of office space by the Mayor of Piti.

The Committee on Finance, Taxation, and Commerce, to which Bill No. 236 (EC), "An Act To Appropriate Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000) For The Rental Of Office Space In Fiscal Year 2006 For The Mayor's Office Of Piti", was referred, does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan TO PASS Bill No. 236 (EC), as substituted by the Committee.

AN ACT TO PLACE THE FORMER INARAJAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FACILITY UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION OF THE INARAJAN MAYOR'S OFFICE; TO INCREASE THE PORTION OF THE MARBO PROPERTY TO BE LEASED FOR A NEW SCHOOL BY AMENDING P.L. 28-68, CHAPTER II, PART I, SECTION 20; AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR THE MAYOR OF PITI TO LEASE OFFICE SPACE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Transfer of Property. The administrative jurisdiction over the former Inarajan Elementary School facility is hereby transferred to the Inarajan Mayor's office to be used for civic and community purposes. Such purposes include, *but are not limited to*, a community center, recreational uses, emergency shelter, police and/or fire station use, library, learning center and senior citizens' center.

Section 2. Item (a) of Section 20 of Part I of Chapter II of Public Law 28-68 is hereby amended to read:

"(a) Authorization to Enter into Lease. For the purpose of facilitating the financing of the design, construction and maintenance of an Education Facility, as defined in Title 5 GCA §58103(e), an Education Agency, namely the Guam Public School System, or the government of Guam, as the case may be, is authorized to lease, to a Contractor, up to thirty-five (35) acres of certain real property located on Guam better described more particularly as that certain real property, located in Yigo, Guam, known as Lot Marbo Base Command "B"-4, consisting of approximately eighty (80) acres, as described in Exhibit "A" of the United States Quitclaim Deed, Instrument Number 479882, of which to construct an Education Facility, as defined in Title 5 GCA §58103(e) pursuant to Chapter 58 of Title 5, also known as the Education Facilities Construction Initiative Act of 2001, as *amended*."

Section 3. Authorization to Make Changes to the RFP. The education agency is authorized to amend the Request For Proposal authorized by Item (b) of Section 20 of Part I of Chapter II of Public Law 28-68 and attached thereto as Exhibit "B" of Public Law 28-68 to allow for the leasing of up to thirty-five (35) acres of certain



real property located on Guam better described more particularly as that certain real property, located in Yigo, Guam, known as Lot Marbo Base Command "B"-4, consisting of approximately eighty (80) acres, as described in Exhibit "A" of the United States Quitclaim Deed, Instrument Number 479882 as authorized by Section 1 of this Act.

Section 4. A new Item (1) is hereby added to Subsection (a) of Section 32 of Chapter III, Public Law 28-68 to read:

"(1) Municipal Office Space Rental. The sum of Twelve Thousand Dollars (\$12,000.00) from the Fiscal Year 2006 General Fund appropriation to the Mayors Council of Guam is authorized for the purpose of funding office space rental for the Mayor of the Municipality of Piti."
