# BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

**Section 1.** Legislative Statement. The administrators of Lot No. 10155-6 and Lot No. 10155-7 located in the municipality of *Dededo*, the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department, respectively, and containing an area of six thousand three hundred nineteen (6,319) square meters and four thousand eight hundred thirty-four (4,834) square meters, respectively, have requested the assistance of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to zone the lots, as they currently have no zone due to its previous status as Federal Excess Land. The

properties are located on Route 1, Marine Corps Drive, *Dededo*. The new zoning will *not* adversely affect the surrounding neighborhood and in fact will provide for increased community benefits and services in the form of police protection and fire protection.

Section 2. A new Section 61313 is hereby *added* to Title 21 GCA, Division 2, Chapter 61, Article 3 to read:

# "§61313. Public Facility (PF). (a) Use Permitted.

- (1) Schools, police stations, fire stations, community centers, recreation centers, senior citizen centers, public health centers, libraries, government buildings and other related facilities."
- **Section 3. Zoning of Lots.** Lot No. 10155-6 and Lot No. 10155-7 located in the municipality of *Dededo*, containing an area of six thousand three hundred nineteen (6,319) square meters and four thousand eight hundred thirty-four (4,834) square meters, respectively, are hereby zoned as Public Facility (PF).

# COMMITTEE REPORT ON BILL NO. 278 (EC)

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW ZONE AND TO ZONE LOT NO. 10155-6 AND LOT NO. 10155-7 MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO.

### I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on General and Omnibus Matters held a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on May 03, 2006 in the Session Hall, I Liheslaturan Guåhan. Public notice was given to all media (see facsimile confirmation page) on April 26 and May 01, 2006.

Senators present at the public hearing were:

Speaker Mark Forbes, Chairman Senator Benjamin J.F. Cruz, Member Senator Robert Klitzkie

### II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Individuals that appeared before the Committee to present oral and written testimony on the bill were as follows:

Mr. Joe Borja, Director, Department of Land Management, oral testimony in support of Bill 278. He said the land has been licensed to GFD and GPD to use. He said that construction of the facilities has commenced but in the process the DLM found out that the land hasn't been properly zoned. He said the construction of the facilities has been fully funded for completion. In addition Mr. Borja stated that the legislature needs to write legislation regarding the new identification of zone areas designated "PF" (Public Facilites). He said that the "PF" Zone is a new description with the DLM.

Mr. Benny Pinaula, Deputy Director, Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, oral testimony in support of Bill 278. Mr. Pinaula said the Federal HUD has been involved with the project since its inception and that GHURA fully supports the intent of Bill 293.

Mr. Frank Ishizaki, Chief of Police, Guam Police Department, oral testimony in support of Bill 278. Chie Ishizaki said GPD fully supports Bill 278 and said that the new facility will benefit the northern half of Guam. He said the precinct will cover an estimated population of 60,000 thousand individuals. The new precinct will service calls for the communities of Dededo and Yigo. Chief Ishizaki said the current facility is presents many problems, such as low morale due to over crowding and lack of security. He said the new facility will boost the morale of the department and will have an eventual increase in work productivity. He further said that the new Fire Department being constructed will replace the Fire Station located at Iglesias Circle in the village of Dededo.

Mr. Joe Garrido, Maga'Lahi, Nasion Chamoru, oral testimony neither in support or against the intent of Bill 278. Mr. Garrido asked the legislature to seek information from GPD and GFD on their inventory of land and assets. He said rather than licensing the property, if either GPD or GFD has available land not being utilized, a land exchange could be done.

Mr. Mar Rivo, Precinct Commander, Guam Police Department, written testimony in support of Bill 278. He states that the new precinct will be state-of-the-art as a great amount of time and ideas were invested on the project by the staffs of GHURA and GPD to ensure its design conforms with current security specifications. (see attached testimony).

### FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on General and Omnibus Matters finds that the intent of Bill No. 278 is to Zone Lot No. 10155-6 and Lot No. 10155-7 both located in Dededo as a "PF" (public facility) Zone. Currently the lots are not zoned and any impact, in relative to the designated zone, will have minimal impact to the surrounding communities. These referenced lots will be used as the future site of the new Guam Police Department Dededo Police Precinct and the new Guam Fire Department Dededo Fire Station. The above referenced land has been licensed to the Guam Fire Department and the Guam Police Department by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, which has been deemed as federal excess property.

Accordingly, the Committee on General and Omnibus Matters to which BILL No. 278 (EC) was referred does hereby submit its findings and recommendations to I Mina' Bente Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan **TO DO PASS BILL No. 278 (EC),** "An Act To Create A New Zone And To Zone Lot No. 10155-6 And Lot No. 10155-7 Municipality Of Dededo."

This is to provide my testimony in support of Bill No. 278 (EC).

The passage of Bill No. 278 is significant to both the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department in that it will enable the construction of the police precinct and the fire station on Lot No. 10155-6 and Lot No. 10155-7, in the municipality of Dededo, respectively. The relocation of the Dededo Precinct to its future site will not adversely affect the surrounding neighborhood and in fact will enable the police department to better serve the community with increased benefits and services in the form of police protection.

The construction of the new Dededo Precinct is a welcomed news for the Guam Police Department. It also brings a sense of relief especially for our police officers assigned to the Dededo Precinct Command. For many years, our officers from the Dededo precinct had to contend with the lack of work space and outdated infrastructure. The design of the current facility is not suited for future expansions to accommodate our spatial needs, unless major structural improvements are made. We are in dire need of spaces for interview rooms, holding cells, a customer waiting area, supervisors' office, officers' lounge, computer room, staff offices, and a lot more.

Because we are prevented from causing any building expansion due to limited space, we are forced to conduct multi-law enforcement activities in almost every office space available. For example, the briefing room, which is intended for conducting officers' briefing, is multi-tasking. The room is not only used for its intended purpose, but it is also used to detain arrested persons, conduct interviews, storage for office supplies and records, and staff meetings. Often times, our officers are forced to delay their briefing or

conduct briefing elsewhere when the briefing room is being used. In cases where there are multiple suspects or witnesses, almost every available room and office in the precinct is used.

The Guam Police Department, in its effort to maximize the use of the Dededo precinct facility, has made some temporary improvements. Portions of the open hallway in front of the precinct were enclosed with wooden plyboard and doors to provide for a holding room, deskwatch room, and a supervisors' office, respectively. Another open area in the same hallway was converted into a waiting area for our police customers. Post office customers often use our waiting area to complete forms or conduct their business with the post office.

The Dededo Precinct is situated in a single building owned by the Dededo Mayor's Office. The building houses the Guam Police Department, Guam Fire Department, and the U.S. Post Office, respectively. We share one small public parking lot with our neighboring agencies. Because the precinct is on the same compound with the other agencies, security hardening for the precinct is a problem. Our situation prevents us from installing barriers or fencing around the building to contain and control public entry to the precinct. To do so would deny public access to the post office and the fire station. The surrounding areas of the building and the parking lot are accessible to the public 24-hours a day, including persons who have the potential to inflict harm on our police officers and our customers. An example is the incident that occurred in the evening during the 1990's when a person drove through the parking lot of our the building and tossed a live hand grenade in the parking lot. Fortunately, no one was injured, but only minor damages to the building was sustained. Can you imagine the results had this incident occurred in the daytime, during business hours, when police officers and their customer, as well as the post office employees and their customers, were present? The results would have been chaotic.

The infrastructure of the building is also problematic. Power surges in some areas of the precinct have been experienced. Often times we had to find a power outlet within the precinct that could support our equipment load. Additionally, the Dededo Precinct is susceptible to flooding during the rainy or typhoon season due to poor drainage system, Rain water from the roadway drains into our parking lot and overflows into our front hallway. The flood replicates a small pond in our parking lot. This posses a safety hazard for our police officers and our customers, as well the post office employees and their customers.

The new precinct will be state-of-the-art as a great amount of time and ideas were invested on the project by the staffs of GHURA and GPD to ensure its design conforms with current security specifications. The precinct will have multiple holding cells and interview rooms, staff and supervisors' offices, officers' lounge, fence enclosure, controlled entrances in selected areas, security cameras, and a lot more.

It is for the reasons I indicated previously that I support your proposal of Bill No. 278. I kindly ask for your support in passing the bill so that we may proceed with the construction of our new precinct.

The construction project is long overdue, and it's about time. The police officers and I from the Dededo Precinct are anxious and excited of the project. The new facility will definitely instill a sense of security for our police officers, but more importantly for our public customers in our district. It will be our officers' new home away from home.

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW ZONE AND TO ZONE LOT NO. 10155-6 AND LOT NO. 10155-7 MUNICIPALITY OF DEDEDO.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Statement. The administrators of Lot No. 10155-6 and Lot 10155-7 located in the municipality of Dededo, the Guam Police Department and the Guam Fire Department, respectively and containing an area of 6319 square meters and 4834 square meters respectively, have requested the assistance of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to zone the lots as they currently have no zone due to its previous status as Federal Excess Land. The properties are located on Route 1, Marine Corps Drive, Dededo. The new zoning will not adversely affect the surrounding neighborhood and in fact will provide for increased community benefits and services in the form of police protection and fire protection.

Section 2. A new section 61313 is added to title 21 GCA to read. §61313. PF(Public Facility). (a) Use Permitted:

(1) Police stations, fire stations, community centers, recreation center, senior citizen center, public health center, libraries, government buildings and other related facilities.
 Section 3. Zoning of Lots. Lot No. 10155-6 and Lot No. 10155-7 located in the municipality of Dededo, containing an area of 6319 square meters and 4834 square meters respectively are hereby zoned as PF (Public Facility.
