Rules of Evidence as adopted by the Supreme Court of Guam through its Promulgation Order Number 06-001 apply to all actions, cases and proceedings brought after said Promulgation Order takes effect and to all actions, cases and proceedings commenced *prior* to the effective date hereof and still pending, *except* to the extent that application of the Rules to those pending actions, cases and proceedings would *not* be feasible, or would work injustice, in which event the evidentiary principles contained in the former Division 1 of Title 6 G.C.A. shall apply, notwithstanding the repeal and reenactment thereof by this Act.

§ 103. Rules of Evidence adopted by the Supreme Court pursuant to this Title shall control regarding any conflict with other law and such other law shall therefore be of *no* further force or effect."

Findings & recommendations:

On January 6, 2006, the Supreme Court adopted the 2006 Guam Rules of Evidence (GROE) by-means-of its <u>Promulgation Order No. 06-001</u>, citing as its authority subsection (a)(6) of §1424-10f the Organic Act, which provides that the Supreme Court is authorized to "make and promulgate rules governing the administration of the judiciary and the practice and procedures in the courts of the judicial branch of Guam, including the procedures for the determination of an appeal en banc."

So as to prevent any ambiguity concerning the Court's ability to establish rules of evidence, the committee finds the necessity to grant the court the express authority to make and from time-to-time amend rules of evidence.

In order to clear the way for the rules of evidence contained in Promulgation Order No. 06-001, it is necessary to repeal the rules of evidence enacted by the statute (6 GCA Div. 1) in 1979. This will provide for the orderly transition from the old statutory rules to the new rules created by the Supreme Court.

The committee finds that Bill 308 accomplishes the necessary changes in law to accommodate the rules of evidence created by the Supreme Court in Promulgation Order No. 06-001.

Accordingly, the Committee on Judiciary, Governmental Operations, and Reorganization, does hereby submit its finding and recommendation to **DO PASS** Bill 308 (EC), An act to Repeal and Reenact Division 1 of Title 6 of the Guam Code Annotated to Repeal and Reenact the Guam Rules of Evidence and to Authorize the Supreme Court of Guam to Adopt and Amend Said Rules in the Future.

Summary of testimony:

Justice Robert J. Torres, co-chair of the Subcommittee on Rules of Evidence Revisions, and F. Philip Carbullido, chief justice of Guam, presented oral and written testimony in support of Bill 308 (EC). Torres and Carbullido stated that the new 2006 Guam Rules of Evidence, as drafted by the Subcommittee on Rules of Evidence Revisions and adopted by the Supreme Court, will help improve the administration of justice by the courts. They highlighted an important fact that the GROE in its current form has not been changed since 1979, 26 years since its inception. They support Bill 308 (EC) as it repeals the current rules and allows the 2006 Guam Rules of Evidence to go into effect.



Testimony in support of Bill No. 308, An act to repeal and reenact Division 1 of Title 6 of the Guam Code Annotated to repeal and reenact the Guam Rules of Evidence and to authorize the Supreme Court of Guam to adopt and amend said rules in the future.

Dear Mr. Chairman and Members of the Committee:

In August 2002, in line with the Guam Supreme Court's renewed efforts to improve the administration of justice by the courts of Guam, Supreme Court's Subcommittee on Rules of Evidence Revisions began reviewing the Guam Rules of Evidence with the aim of updating the rules which were unchanged since their adoption in 1979.

The Subcommittee, co-chaired by Associate Justice Robert J. Torres, Jr. and Judge Katherine A. Maraman, included members from a wide cross-section of the Guam Bar including: Georgette Bello-Concepcion, Esq., William Gavras, Esq., Stephen Hattori, Esq., Ms. Stephanie Sato, Traylor T. Mercer, Esq., Julie Rivera, Esq., and Charles Troutman, Deputy Attorney General. The Subcommittee carefully and deliberately reviewed the rules and prepared draft rules which were sent to the general membership of the Guam Bar Association for comment. On January 3, 2006, the Subcommittee submitted its report to the Supreme Court recommending adoption of the 2006 Guam Rules of Evidence.

In Promulgation Order No. 06-001, the Supreme Court, pursuant to its Organic Act authority, adopted the 2006 Guam Rules of Evidence which will become effective upon the repeal of the current Rules of Evidence codified at Division 1 of Title 6 of the Guam Code Annotated. Repeal of Division 1 is necessary to avoid confusion over the applicability of the new rules.

Bill 308 repeals the present Guam Rules of Evidence, which have not been amended in over 26 years, and allows the 2006 Rules of Evidence to come into effect. Therefore, the Judiciary supports the expeditious passage of Bill No. 308.

AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT DIVISION 1'OF TITLE 6 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED TO REPEAL AND REENACT THE GUAM RULES OF EVIDENCE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE SUPREME COURT OF GUAM TO ADOPT AND AMEND SAID RULES IN THE FUTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section One: Title 6, Division 1 of the Guam Code Annotated is repealed and reenacted to read:

4 "DIVISION 1

5 GUAM RULES OF EVIDENCE

§ 101 The Supreme Court of Guam may adopt and from time-to-time amend Rules of Evidence by Promulgation Order.

§ 102. Rules of Evidence as adopted by the Supreme Court of Guam through its Promulgation Order Number 06-001 apply to all actions, cases and proceedings brought after said Promulgation Order takes effect and to all actions, cases and proceedings commenced prior to the effective date hereof and still pending, except to the extent that application of the rules to those pending actions, cases and proceedings would not be feasible, or would work injustice, in which event the evidentiary principles contained in the former Division 1 of Title 6 G.C.A. shall apply, notwithstanding the repeal and reenactment thereof by this act.

§ 103. Rules of Evidence adopted by the Supreme Court pursuant to this Title shall control regarding any conflict with other law and such other law shall therefore be of no further force or effect."
