



I. Overview:

The Committee on Education and Community Development convened for a public hearing at 9:00 a.m., Friday, June 2, 2006 to receive testimony on Bill No. 314 (EC): An Act to Add a New Item (3) to Paragraph (a) of §15A301 of Chapter 15 of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated Relative to Setting a Minimum Cumulative High School GPA for Merit Award Eligibility. Notice of the hearing was disseminated throughout all local media for announcements on Friday, May 26, 2006. Notice was also made known via electronic media on the 28th Guam Legislature's Web Page, <u>www.guamlegislature.com</u>, under the link, "Legislative Calendar," since May 27, 2006.

> II. Summaries of Testimonies:

Mr. Patrick Clymer, Guam Community College

Mr. Clymer, representing the Guam Community College, testified that he was in favor of the bill, but recommends a 4.0 grade point average amendment.

Mr. John Anderson, Guam Public School System

Mr. Anderson, representing the Guam Public School System, testified that the department is in favor of the bill saying that it is a good idea to put an end point to the Merit Scholarship as there are on other scholarships available to students. He mentioned that school counselors will support the bill as well as standards are set in place.

Mr. Tom Babauta, Guam Public School System

Mr. Babauta was present during the hearing to support the department's testimony.

Mr. Mark C. Cruz, University of Guam

Mr. Cruz, representing the University of Guam's Financial Aid Office as the acting Director, submitted written testimony stating that the University supports the intent of the bill. They request that the phrase "or equivalent" be inserted after "...not less than 3.000", informing the Committee that schools use various grading systems.

III. Findings and Recommendations:

The Committee on Education and Community Development, to which was referred Bill No. 314 (EC): An Act to Add a New Item (3) to Paragraph (a) of §15A301 of Chapter 15 of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated Relative to Setting a Minimum Cumulative High School GPA for Merit Award Eligibility. The Committee finds that a cut off bracket needs to be in place for the Merit Award. Setting a cut off bracket would allow for students to look to achieving a higher scholastic grade point average. The bill will also make certain that students receiving the Merit Award are not below standard academically. Therefore, the Committee reports back with its recommendation **TO DO PASS**.

Dear Senator Kasperbauer:

Thank you for allowing the University the opportunity to provide written testimony on Bill 314. The University of Guam supports the intent of Bill 314 – Relative to setting a minimum cumulative high school gpa for Ment award eligibility. Students entitled to the Merit Award are students having the highest scholastic standing of a graduating class therefore it is fitting to require a cumulative 3.0 grade point average at the time of graduation. However, we do ask that you insert the phrase "or equivalent" after the 3.0 on a 4.0 scale statement to account for those who use a different grading system. The University community welcomes this change to the Merit Award Program.

Our response to the questions mentioned in our telephone conversation with Ms. Sahara Defensor regarding to Bill 314 are as follows:

- 1. How many students are under the Merit Award program? AY 2005-2006 - 133 (UOG) and 14 (Off-Island)
- 2. What is the percentage of students with a certain gpa (i.e. 4.0, 3.9, etc.) from high school under the Merit award program?

The UOG-FAO does not collect this information because it is not a requirement for eligibility purposes. The current Criteria of Eligibility to receive the Merit is as follows:

- To qualify for a Merit Award, the student:
- (a) must be a graduate from a public or private high school that is licensed to do business on Guam;
- (b) shall be one(s) having the highest academic scholastic standing of their respective graduating classes based on four (4) completed consecutive years of attendance in public or private high schools, generally open to all students on Guam, except the Department of Defense Schools;
- (c) (1) a United States citizen; or (2) a permanent resident alien; and
- (d) must be a resident of Guam for a continuous period of not less than five (5) years immediately proceeding June 15th of the year the award is to be awarded.
- 3. What scale is used to determine grade point average (i.e. percentage or decimal)? The Financial Aid Office will ask the UOG Registrar.

Some concerns our office has with Bill 314 are as follows:

- 1. Who determines the equivalency? The language regarding the conversion or computation of a student's grade point average should be determined by the UOG Registrar so the requirement of a 3.0 cumulative grade point average prior to entering the Merit Award program will take in account of schools with honor classes and the +/- grades.
- 2. Will the effective eligibility requirement of a 3.0 be applicable to the high school graduation class of Spring 2007 or AY 2007-2008?
- 3. Have the public and non-public school on Guam been notified about this change?
- 4. Has research been conducted with the public and non-public schools to estimate the possible impact of this new eligibility requirement on the next graduating senior class?

In addition, we would like your office to consider the following recommended changes for the effectiveness of the Merit Award (UOG and Off-Island) program:

Current Practice

- Airfare benefits: one-way to institution and one-way to Guam upon completion of degree program.
- Tuition and fees for all registered classes at UOG.
- Top-ranked student pursuing a degree offisland have the option to leave on their initial year in college (problems associated with this practice are change of major programs, change of institutions, etc.).
- No stipulation for bankruptcy waivers of service or monetary obligations.
- Current penalties for cancelled/forfeited accounts is 10%.
- Deferment for continued education. The language that is used is not cleared defined, currently it states "must be attending a professional or graduate studies".
- Required to be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident Alien

Proposal for Change

- Cancel airfare benefits.
- Restrict tuition/fees benefits to courses level of 100 and above.
- Mandatory 1st year attending UOG, provides the student the opportunity to ensure the degree of pursuit, institution of attendance, etc. Option to stay at UOG for the 2nd year; however, if recipient is planning on transferring must do so before the beginning of the 3rd year.
- Need to incorporate some type of language on the non-waiver of debt due to bankruptcy.
- Tougher penalties for recipients who default due to employment elsewhere 15%.
- (More careful definition) of deferments granted for students admitted to a Master's or Ph.D. degree program.
- Required to be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident Alien by June 15th of the preceding award year.



BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Item (3) is hereby *added* to paragraph (a) of Section
15A301 of Chapter 15 of 17GCA to read:

- 6 less than 3.000 at the time of graduation."
