**1. Amend Section 1 of Part I of Chapter II reading:**

"Section 1. **Guam Public School System Operations Fund.** Section 52101 of Chapter 52 of Division 2 of Title 11 of the Guam Code Annotated is repealed and reenacted to read:

**"Chapter 52**

§ 52101. **Creation of the Guam Public School System Operations Fund.** There is hereby created, separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam, a fund known as the 'Guam Public School System Operations Fund'. This fund shall *not* be commingled with the General Fund and shall be kept in a separate bank account to be in the name of the Guam Public School System (GPSS). The amount appropriated by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to the Guam Public School System for its annual operations shall be deposited in the Guam Public School System Operations Fund to cover the operational expenses of the Guam Public School System and any use associated with the Guam Public School System, as determined in the Guam Public School System budget in accordance with 10 GCA Chapter 3, by the Guam Education Policy Board or the laws of Guam. The Superintendent of Education shall conduct public hearings at the public schools prior to the submission of the budget to the Guam Education Policy Board in order to address each school's individual budgetary requirements. The Superintendent of Education shall create and submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* and the Director of Administration projected schedules of monthly cash disbursement for each ~~school and division~~ <sup>(a)</sup> school/division/program, by expenditure category, for the fiscal year. Such projected disbursements shall not exceed the total amount appropriated by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for the purpose of such appropriation. The Public Auditor shall approve the schedules.

(c) Thirty (30) days after the approval of the cash disbursement schedules, the Superintendent of Education shall certify and submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan*, the Director of Administration and the Public Auditor, a revised budget document, in the format of the FY 2007 Budget Call forms of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research, which shall reflect all adjustments to the detailed breakdown contained in the original GPSS budget submittal to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, to be consistent with the amounts allocated for each school/division in the GPSS projected cash disbursement schedule prepared by the Superintendent and approved by the Public Auditor. All quantities and items must be adjusted accordingly. The revised budget document will be a guide for each school/division/program, as well as the *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* and the Public Auditor, to ensure that appropriated funds are being used for the purposes intended. The revised budget document shall be posted, in its entirety, on the GPSS' website and such posted budget document shall be updated each quarter. Penalties imposed for non-compliance with reporting requirements shall apply to this provision.

The Director of Administration shall deposit, on the last day of each month, a sum equal to the amount required by the projected schedules of cash disbursement prepared by the

Superintendent, into the Guam Public School System Operations Fund, *except* that the Director of Administration for the first (1st) month of the fiscal year, on the first Friday of October, shall make a deposit equal to the amount required for the first month of the fiscal year, as reflected in the Guam Public School System's projected monthly schedules of cash disbursements, from the prior month's General Fund revenue collections. The Director of Administration shall, on the first (1st) day of each month, transfer to the Guam Public School System all funds held in the Guam Public School System Operations Fund, *except* that for the first (1st) month of Fiscal Year 2007, on October 15, 2006, the Director of Administration shall transfer all funds contained in the Guam Public School System Operations Fund to the Guam Public School System.

Before releasing the appropriation allotment to any government entity other than the Guam Public School System or from any other appropriation, the Director of the Bureau of Budget and Management Research shall *first* ensure that the Director of Administration has deposited the monthly cash requirement of the Guam Public School System into the Guam Public School System Operations Fund.

Nothing herein shall be construed as preventing *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* from making additional appropriations to the Guam Public School System. *I Maga'lahren Guåhan's* transfer authority shall *not* apply to this or any other appropriation to the Guam Public School System, *except* that *I Maga'lahren Guåhan* may transfer funds into the Guam Public School System to the extent permitted by law. *I Maga'lahren Guåhan* may transfer to the Guam Public School System funds in excess of the amounts appropriated to the Guam Public School System herein if he determines that an emergency has created a need for such a transfer. "

17       **Section 2. Funding for the Guam Public School System for FY**  
18 **2007.** The amounts, in the Subsections below, totaling One Hundred  
19 Eighty-four Million Three Hundred Forty-six Thousand Four Hundred  
20 Sixty-six Dollars (**\$184,346,466**) are made from the following Funds, and for  
21 the following purposes, to the Guam Public School System for Fiscal Year  
22 2007:

1           **A. Guam Public School System Operations Fund Appropriation.**

2 Pursuant to Sections 52101 and 52102 of Chapter 52, Division 2 of Title 11  
3 Guam Code Annotated, as amended by this Act, the sum of One Hundred  
4 Seventy-two Million Nine Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Eight Hundred  
5 Four Dollars (**\$172,957,804**), inclusive of such sums necessary for the  
6 implementation of teacher salary adjustments pursuant to Public Law 28-  
7 36, as amended by Section 26 of Part I of Chapter II of Public Law 28-68,  
8 based on the fourteen percent (14%) teacher salary adjustments  
9 recommended by the Department of Administration, is appropriated from  
10 the General Fund to the Guam Public School System Operations Fund for  
11 Fiscal Year 2007.

12           **B. Interscholastic Sports Fund.** For Fiscal Year 2007, the sum of  
13 Five Hundred Nine Thousand Two Hundred Forty-six Dollars (**\$509,246**) is  
14 appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund to the Interscholastic Sports  
15 Fund within the Guam Public School System to fund Interscholastic Sports  
16 Programs. Expenditure of these funds will comply with Title 17 GCA  
17 §7108.

18           **C. Health and Physical Education Activities.** For Fiscal Year  
19 2007, the sum of Three Hundred Twenty Four Thousand Four Hundred  
20 Sixteen Dollars (**\$324,416**) is appropriated from the Healthy Futures Fund  
21 to the Guam Public School System for Health/Physical Education  
22 programs, intramural sports, and similar activities.

**"A. Guam Public School System Operations Fund Appropriation.** Pursuant to Sections 52101 and 52102 of Chapter 52, Division 2 of Title 11 Guam Code Annotated, as amended by this Act, the sum of One Hundred Seventy-two Million Nine Hundred Fifty-seven Thousand Eight Hundred Four Dollars (\$172,957,804), which is inclusive of such sums necessary for the implementation of teacher salary adjustments for locally funded teacher positions pursuant to Public Law 28-36, as amended by Section 26 of Part I of Chapter II of Public Law 28-68, based on the fourteen percent (14%) teacher salary adjustments recommended by the Department of Administration; and, which is also inclusive to the sum not exceeding One Million Ninety Eight Thousand Three Hundred Forty-Five Dollars (\$1,098,345.00) for software, training, system conversion services, consulting/project management, hardware servers, hardware storage peripherals and hardware redundancy systems in the implementation of the Guam Public School System Student Management System is appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Public School System Operations Fund for Fiscal Year 2007. This appropriation shall be expended in accordance with the revised budget document and for the items reflected therein and in accordance with the approved cash disbursement schedules as mandated in this Act."

Located on page 4 line 23; amend Subsection (D) of Section 2, Part II of Chapter II of Bill 266 (EC) to read:

**"D. Y Kuantan Salappe' Prinsepat (Principals' Fund).**

(1) The sum of Five Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Dollars (\$555,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the Guam Public School System for the Principals' Fund for Fiscal Year 2007. The amount appropriated herein shall be allocated per student to each school, based on the student population of each school at the end of the prior school year; provided that no school shall receive less than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000). Notwithstanding the provisions of Sections 10101 and 10102 of Title 17 GCA, each school shall use the proceeds it receives to develop and implement a program to protect schools from vandalism. Principals shall coordinate with the school's Parent Teacher Organization and submit an anti vandalism program to the Superintendent for approval.

2 Dollars (\$555,000) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to the  
3 Guam Public School System for the Principals' Fund for Fiscal Year 2007.  
4 The amount appropriated herein shall be allocated per student to each  
5 school, based on the student population of each school at the end of the  
6 prior school year; provided that no school shall receive less than Five  
7 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000).

8                   (2) Any unreleased and unexpended appropriations  
9 made by Section 5 of Part I of Chapter II of Public Law 28-68 may be  
10 expended in Fiscal Year 2007.

11           **E. School Nutritional Meals.** Up to Six Million Five Hundred  
12 Thousand Dollars (\$6,500,000) is appropriated from the School  
13 Lunch/SAE/Child Nutritional Meal Reimbursement Fund to the Guam  
14 Public School System for non-personnel operating expenses incurred in  
15 accordance with established guidelines for said programs.

16           **F. Appropriation to the Guam Public School System for**  
17 **Summer School.** For Fiscal Year 2007, there is hereby appropriated such  
18 sums as are necessary from the Summer School Fund established pursuant  
19 to §6119 of Article 1 of Chapter 6 of Division 1 of Title 17 Guam Code  
20 Annotated, to the Guam Public School System to fund the operations of the  
21 2007 Summer School Program. The Superintendent of Education shall  
22 submit a detailed report to *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I*  
23 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* regarding the receipt and expenditure of said funds *no*

1 *later than* thirty (30) days after the close of summer school and post the  
2 same on the website. Such report shall include the following:

3 (1) total revenues received, including identification of  
4 each revenue source;

5 (2) total expenditures and encumbrance by object  
6 classification and by school; and

7 (3) the fund balance.

8 **G. Appropriation for Textbooks and Collateral Materials.** The  
9 following are appropriations to the Guam Public School System for the  
10 purchase of textbooks, e-book readers and collateral materials to include  
11 software, sheet music and music books in accordance with the conditions  
12 and terms expressed in the following subsections:

13 (1) For Fiscal Year 2007, the sum of Three Million Five  
14 Hundred Thousand Dollars (**\$3,500,000**) is appropriated from the General  
15 Fund from Fiscal Year 2008 revenues to the Guam Public School System  
16 (Public Schools) for the purchase of textbooks, e-book readers and  
17 collateral classroom instructional materials to include software, sheet music  
18 and music books. The Superintendent may, *if necessary*, in agreements  
19 with textbook vendors, defer payment until *after* October 1, 2007, but *not*  
20 *later than* December 31, 2007, with the full faith and credit of the  
21 government of Guam.

22 (2) Public Schools shall order all textbooks, e-book readers  
23 and collateral classroom instructional materials to include software, sheet

1 music and music books funded by this Section *no later than* March 1, 2007  
2 for Fiscal Year 2008, and the Bureau of Budget and Management Research  
3 shall release such allotments as are required to ensure that such textbooks,  
4 e-book readers and collateral classroom instructional materials to include  
5 software, sheet music and music books are ordered by this deadline. All  
6 textbooks and collateral classroom instructional materials to include  
7 software, sheet music and music books shall be received and distributed to  
8 schools *no later than* thirty (30) days prior to the start of the school calendar  
9 established pursuant to Title 17 Guam Code Annotated §4111, as repealed  
10 and reenacted by this Act. All funds appropriated for textbooks, e-book  
11 readers and collateral classroom instructional materials to include  
12 software, sheet music and music books shall *not* be used for any other  
13 purpose.

14 (3) For Fiscal Year 2007, on the first (1st) day of each fiscal  
15 quarter, the Superintendent of Education shall provide a detailed report to  
16 *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on all receipts  
17 and expenditures for textbooks, e-book readers and collateral classroom  
18 instructional materials to include software, sheet music and music books.  
19 The report shall be accompanied by the certified list of textbooks approved  
20 by the Guam Education Policy Board and all purchase orders issued. The  
21 report shall be posted on the Public School's website. The report shall  
22 include summaries of the following information:

1 (a) purchases by allotment account number, unit cost  
2 and total cost of books charged against appropriation  
3 account, vendor, quantity, title, copyright date and ISBN  
4 number of books ordered, allocation of such books by  
5 school and grade, and statements as to whether books are  
6 for teachers or students and whether books are textbooks  
7 or e-books;

8 (b) the number of textbooks and e-book readers lost or  
9 damaged, the amounts collected for such lost or damaged  
10 items and the amount of receivables due for such lost or  
11 damaged items for the preceding fiscal year and the  
12 current fiscal year by month; and

13 (c) other information that may be useful, or requested  
14 by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, regarding the accountability of  
15 funds appropriated for such purposes.

16 Non-compliance with reporting requirements by the Superintendent of  
17 Education shall result in sanctions/penalties imposed pursuant to this Act.

18 **Section 3. Website Posting.** The Guam Public School System shall  
19 include in its website the following:

20 a) All payments for prior year obligations to be paid by current  
21 appropriation, salary adjustments by position and the  
22 funding source for each, by month.

23 b) Cash Disbursement Schedules created pursuant to this Act.

- 1 c) Number of filled FTEs, cost and funding source by school  
2 and/or division by month.  
3 d) Number of vacant FTEs, cost and funding source by school  
4 and/or division by month.

**B. Special Fund Appropriation for Operations.** The sum of Two Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Two Hundred Sixty-one Dollars (\$2,260,261) is appropriated from the Territorial Education Facilities Fund to the University of Guam for its operations in Fiscal Year 2007.

**D. Scholarships and Training Programs.** The following appropriations are made to the University of Guam for Fiscal Year 2007.

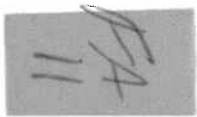

“(2) Dr. Antonio C. Yamashita Educator Corps. The sum of One Million Three Hundred Fourteen Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-six Dollars (\$1,314,696) is appropriated from the General Fund to the University of Guam for Fiscal Year 2007, ~~which~~ The President shall disburse the funds pursuant to the directives and policies of the Educator Corps Council, for stipends for the Dr. Antonio C. Yamashita Educator Corps and for the administration of the ~~Educator Corps Council program~~, in accordance with the provisions of ~~Public Law 24-231, 17 GCA, Chapter 18~~ and §15107 of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated, as amended.”



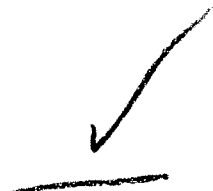

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CHAPTER II.

Part VI – EDUCATIONAL MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS.

Section 1. Purchasing In Economies of Scale. All departments and agencies receiving appropriations pursuant to this Act shall take all necessary measures to realize cost savings by purchasing supplies and materials in such a manner as to realize economies of scale.

Section 2. Reporting Requirements. No later than thirty (30) days after the close of every fiscal quarter of FY 2007, every director, administrator or head of a government of Guam agency, including line agencies, autonomous and semi-autonomous agencies, public corporations, the Offices of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor, and the Judiciary of Guam, regardless of the source of the entity's appropriations and revenue, shall submit to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and post on the entity's website, in electronic format (including, but not limited to, diskettes, CDs and email) a report making full disclosure of ALL funds under his or her purview and administration for the preceding quarter. Said report shall be in the form of Financial Statements or revenue and expenditure reports for every fund he or she administers, whether said fund is appropriated, non-appropriated, local, federal, regardless of the source of the funding. This and every reporting requirement imposed by this Act or any Act pertaining to FY 2007 shall be subject to the following:

- (a) If the head of an executive branch line agency, autonomous and semi-autonomous agency, public corporation or any part of the


