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**Guam Public School System
Budget Hearing – May 25, 2006**

**Mr. Luis Reyes

Good afternoon Honorable Senator Eddie Calvo and members of the 28th Guam Legislature. For the record my name is Luis Reyes, Interim Superintendent of Education. The proposed GPSS budget for FY 2007 can best be understood in terms of the processes and assumptions that educators used to formulate the budget.

The fiscal year 2007 Guam Public System budget was prepared in accordance with the standards established under the "Every Child is Entitled to an Adequate Education Act" (CAPE). All school principals and division heads participated in the process by providing input and recommendations on how to meet the established standards. Principals and administrators participated in training seminars and meetings with management to provide assistance and guidance in the preparation of the individual detailed budgets from each school and division.

It is important to note that school principals held public hearings for their respective budgets from January 23 – 31, 2006 by district.

District Lagu had two public hearings (Jan. 23 & 24)

District Haya had two public hearings (Jan. 27 & 30)

District Kattan one public hearing (Jan. 26)

District Luchan one public hearing (Jan. 31)

The hearings were held to maximize input from parents, teachers and other stakeholders.

The procedures and assumptions below were used in the budget preparation:

1. Student population was provided by each individual school principal. The total student population was determined to be 31,672 for all elementary, middle, and high schools.
2. All principals and division heads were provided a budget template to review and complete. This template was prepared based on the standards of the CAPE. Items submitted included their current staffing patterns, classroom air conditioning requirements, sink requirements, electrical outlet requirements, toilet and urinal requirements, textbook requirements, equipment and capital outlay requests.
3. The templates were then submitted to the Superintendent for compilation and budget preparation.

4. The budget was then compiled into a fourteen point presentation as noted below:

1. A certified teacher for every class in a ratio established by relevant collective bargaining agreement;
2. Certified professional administrators;
3. Certified guidance counselors;
4. Certified school health counselors;
5. Certified allied health professionals;
6. Air conditioned or properly ventilated classrooms in which the sensible air temperature is no greater than 78°F.;
7. Potable water sufficient to provide each student a daily ration of drinking and washing water;
8. A reliable supply of electricity;
9. Proper sanitation to include flushable toilets, clean restrooms, dining areas, and classrooms;
10. Adopted and required textbooks and workbooks issued to each public school student for the classes in which he or she is enrolled;
11. Libraries, which meet the standards of the American Association of School Librarians, at each school, operated by certified librarians;
12. A healthful, safe, sanitary learning environment;
13. At least one hundred eighty (180) instructional days each school year with school years ending no later than thirty (30) days following the end of the calendared school year; and
14. Regular, timely school bus transportation to and from the school for his attendance area as established by 17 GCA §6102 for every child in accordance with policies adopted by the Education Policy Board.

5. Points #1 thru #5 were determined using student population by school. Student population as of September 30, 2005 were used to determine the required number of certified teachers, certified professional administrators, certified guidance counselors, certified school health counselors, and certified allied health professionals.

6. Air conditioning requirements under point number 6 were provided by each school principal. This included the total number of rooms needing air conditioning, total number of rooms needing air condition repair, and the total number of rooms needing air conditioning replacement. A standard labor rate of \$60 per hour was used to determine the estimated repair costs to include a standard replacement cost of \$1,400 (current replacement cost for 36K BTU split unit).

7. Potable water requirements under point number 7 consist of actual water billings in SY 2005 - 2006. These were adjusted for anticipated rate increases of 4.75%. Additionally, principals included numbers of sinks and water fountains needing repair or replacement. A standard labor rate of \$50 per hour was used to determine the estimated repair costs and a standard replacement cost of \$250 per sink was used to determine the estimated sink replacement costs. A standard replacement cost of \$695 per water fountain was used to determine the estimated water fountain replacement costs.

8. Reliable supplies of electricity requirements under point number 8 consist of actual power billings in SY 2005 - 2006. These were adjusted for anticipated rate increases of 2.5%. Additionally, \$1.8M relating to the annual debt service requirement for a note due to GPA was allocated to each school based on student population. The note, entered into FY 2004, was for unpaid power bills amounting to \$15.9M in interest and penalties. Lastly, principals included numbers of electrical outlets

needing addition or replacement. This was to be accomplished with labor provided by the Facilities & Maintenance Division. A standard replacement cost of \$3.25 per electrical outlet was used to determine the estimated addition and replacement costs of the outlets.

9. Proper sanitation requirements under point number 9 consist of repair or replacement of toilets and urinals. A standard repair cost of \$150 per toilet was used to determine the estimated repair costs per toilet. A standard replacement cost of \$800 per toilet and \$450 per urinal was used to determine the estimated toilet and urinal replacement costs. Additionally, outsourced custodial services are included under this point for those schools that have partial or full outsourcing. This cost is determined on a school basis based on SY 2005-2006 cost.

NOTE: SUPPLIES WERE DETERMINED USING SCHOOL POPULATION MULTIPLIED BY \$114. THIS TOTAL WAS THEN ALLOCATED BETWEEN POINT #9 "CLEANING SUPPLIES" AND "RESTROOM MATERIALS" AND POINT #13C "SUPPLIES, ADMIN/SUPPLIES, NURSE, ETC. AND SUPPLIES DETERMINED BY CHILD NUTRITION WAS PROVIDED BY FOOD SERVICES AND IS NOT INCLUDED IN THIS ALLOCATION.

10. Adopted required textbooks under point number 10 were determined by each school's anticipated population. The costs per book, workbook, and teacher addition was based on an average cost of SY 2005 - 2006 book purchases. Although not allocated to each school, a freight cost of 2.5% of total textbook cost will be requested to be included in the textbook appropriation for SY 2006 - 2007.

11. Library requirements under point number 11 were provided by each school principal as based on the American Association of School Librarians. Library "materials needed" was determined taking student population and multiplying it by \$20. Library "technology enhancements" was also determined by student population (student population < 1,000, then \$3,000 was allocated; student population > 1,000, then \$5,000 was allocated).

12. A healthful, safe, sanitary learning environment required under point number 12 consist of actual SY 2005 - 2006 costs or cost estimates for services ranging from security, to pest control and fire system repair or replacement. Information was provided by each school principal in preparation of this point.

13. The 180 day instructional requirement under point number 13 consists of the remaining items necessary to complete the operations of the school. These items range from school support staff requirements, to contractual requirements for copying services, telephone billings, estimated E-Rate wiring costs, supplies and materials and requested capital outlays. School principals provided input in the preparation of this point. Also included is an allocation of the "indirect costs" allocated from the support divisions that provide support services to each school. The total division cost was divided by the total school population of 31,672. This was done to arrive at the per student cost allocation (\$680.53106 per student). This was then multiplied by the total school population. Lastly, this budget item includes the differential between amounts reimbursed to the GPSS from the Child & Nutrition Services Program estimate for SY 2006 - 2007. This amount varies from school to school depending upon student participation. These balances were provided by the Food and Nutrition Services Division. (NOTE: SEE NOTE AT POINT #9.)

14. Regular, timely school bus transportation to and from the school required under point number 14 is to be addressed by the Department of Public Works.

It is essential to understand that the GPSS FY 2007 budget is affected by the proportion of cash that has been released to GPSS in FY 2006 and 2005.

As of May 1, 2006, GPSS has received \$97,954,730.07, which is approximately \$5.6 M more than what the school system should have received given projected tax collection. It should be noted however, that GPSS did not receive \$9.7 million of what should have been released to them for FY 2005. GPSS therefore has yet to be paid \$4.2 million of its approved budget for SY 2005.

In summary, GPSS developed a budget that is grounded on the 14-point Every Child is Entitled to an Adequate Education mandate. We believe that we can provide every child with an adequate education, but we also believe that every child should be provided an education that is more than adequate. It begins with each one of us in this room today.

Relative to requesting the *I Mina Bente Ocho na Liheslaturan Guahan* (28th Guam Legislature) to Adjust the Funding Formula for the Guam Public School System

COMES NOW, the Guam Education Policy Board and resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, the Liheslaturan Guåhan through enactment of P.L. No. 28-45 has established that the education of our children is the top priority of our government and as a result the first use of the resources of the government must be directed to provide an adequate education for all Guam's children,

WHEREAS, the Liheslaturan Guåhan has enacted a funding source for the Guam Public Schools consisting of 83.2% of all Withholding Taxes, including Interest and Penalties collected; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Education Policy Board finds that total projected receipts from this source from the beginning of the fiscal year through the end of Fiscal Year 2006 will total \$138,570,318.16; and

WHEREAS, the predicted discrepancy between appropriation and projected receipts is a negative \$21,444,041.84 for fiscal year 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Guam Education Policy Board finds that the existing funding formula was chosen based on an estimate of revenues which has not been fulfilled; and

WHEREAS, even if properly complied with, the current funding formula will result in the Guam Public School System not receiving the total appropriation \$160,014,360.00 authorized by the Liheslaturan Guåhan; and

WHEREAS, the projected shortfall of \$21,444,041.84 cannot be met by transferring funds within the Guam Public School System's existing budget,

WHEREAS, the Guam Public School System faces the additional challenge of purchasing textbooks for public and other schools in the amount of \$3,763,990.84, and no funds are currently available for this purpose,


WHEREAS, the Guam Education Policy Board wishes to express its gratitude to the Governor of Guam, the Honorable Felix P. Camacho, and the Liheslaturan Guåhan for their sincere efforts to adequately fund the public schools, and request that these efforts be continued by a review and adjustment of the existing funding formula so that additional funding in the amount \$21,444,041.84 before the end of the fiscal year so that our common goal of making the educational needs of our children the Government of Guam's top priority can be fulfilled.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE FUNDING FORMULA PROVIDED BY P.L. NO. 28-68 BE ADJUSTED TO PROVIDE THE ADDITIONAL \$21,444,041.84 WHICH IS REQUIRED TO OPERATE THE GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, THAT THE GUAM EDUCATION POLICY BOARD DULY AND REGULARLY ADOPTED RESOLUTION NUMBER 2006-_____ ON THIS _____ DAY OF MAY, 2006.

**E-Rate Status Report by Schools
August 22, 2006**

This information sheet is to provide you with common terms, history and the status of each school.

Definitions

MDF – Main Distribution Frame – usually located in the main office of a school. It is where all the conduits and wires come to connect all the parts of the school or office location.

IDF – Intermediate Distribution Frame – usually located in a classroom or mechanical/storage room. This is where the conduits and wires of a wing of a school come to a common point. The IDF then connects back to the MDF.

IMO – Information Management Outlet – This is the connection box in a classroom or office where the computer, telephone or video cable will connect to.

Patch Cable – The cable that connects the computer to the box in the classroom or office.

PBX – Private Branch Exchange - This is the type of phone system that the GPSS will be converting to in the next two months. It provides for phone access in classrooms and offices as well as voicemail.

IP – Internet Protocol – This is the language the computers and other devices use to talk to each other.

PolyCom – This is the camera connected to a television and can conduct video conferences from one location to another through the GPSS network.

VTC – Video Tele-Conferencing – This is one location talking to another location through a camera and television via the GPSS network.

LAN – Local Area Network – This is a network of computers and devices located in one area. A school would be considered a LAN

WAN – Wide Area Network – This is a network of LANs in different locations. The GPSS network would be considered a WAN.

SLD – Schools and Libraries Division – The division of the Universal Services Administrative Company (USAC) that provides the funding for e-rate.

E-Rate History

The E-rate Program was created out of the passage of the 1996 Telecommunications Act by Congress. The intent is to provide Internet Access to schools, libraries and health facilities that did not have access because of the high cost, unavailability in areas, or impoverished communities.

Eligibility for discounts is based on student/family income. GPSS did not apply in the first year of the program, but has applied for every year thereafter and received funding. GPSS current funding discount at the district level is 88% and will be at the 87% level for Funding Year 2006. E-Rate funding year is from July 1 to June 30.
