**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §3101.2 TO ARTICLE 1,  
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 16 OF THE GUAM CODE  
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO DRIVER LICENSE  
RENEWAL FOR ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY PERSONNEL.**

1           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2           **Section 1.** A new §3101.2 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 16 of the Guam  
3 Code Annotated is hereby *added* to read as follows:

4           “§3101.2. License: Effect of Military Service.

1           (a) Unless suspended, canceled or revoked, a driver's license issued  
2 under this Title that is held by a person who is on active duty in the armed forces  
3 of the United States and is absent from Guam, notwithstanding the expiration date  
4 of the license, remains valid as provided herein. *If* the licensee is honorably  
5 discharged from active duty, the license remains valid until the earlier of (1) the  
6 91<sup>st</sup> day after the date of the discharge; *or* (2) the 31<sup>st</sup> day from the date on which  
7 the person returns to Guam, provided that the licensee has discharge *or* separation  
8 papers in his immediate possession.

9           (b) The Director of Revenue and Taxation shall renew the license,  
10 without examination, of a licensee whose license remains valid as defined in  
11 Subsection (a) hereof and who presents evidence of discharge *or* separation from  
12 service in the armed forces within the time limits in said Subsection.”
