

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §3219 OF TITLE 17 G.C.A. TO  
PERMIT THE WORLD WAR I VETERANS TO  
RECEIVE AN HONORARY HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1.** Title 17 G.C.A. §3219 is *amended* to read:

3                “§3219. *Onra I Manfåyi*. (a) The Guam Public School System with  
4 the cooperation of the Office of Veterans Affairs (‘Office’) shall develop and  
5 administer a program to be known as ‘*Onra I Manfåyi*’. The purpose of the Program  
6 is to award honorary high school diplomas to World War I, World War II, Korean

1 War and Vietnam Conflict Veterans, as well as persons who served in World War II in  
2 the Guam Combat Patrol, Wake Island Defenders, Guam Militia or Civilian Scouts.  
3 The Guam Public School System and the Office shall jointly develop an application  
4 procedure, distribute applications and publicize the Program.

5 (b) The Guam Public School System may award an honorary high school  
6 diploma to a current or former Guam resident who:

7 (1) did not return to school and complete his or her education after  
8 the war; and

9 (2) served in the United States armed services during World War I  
10 from 1917 through 1918, World War II from 1939 through 1947, during  
11 the Korean War from 1950 to 1955, or the Vietnam Conflict from 1961  
12 through 1975, and

13 (i) died in active service; or

14 (ii) was honorably discharged.

15 (c) A current or former Guam resident, who did not receive a high school  
16 diploma and served during World War II in the Guam Combat Patrol, Wake  
17 Island Defenders, Guam Militia or Civilian Scouts, may receive an honorary  
18 high school diploma.

19 (d) If a person who would have qualified for an honorary high school  
20 diploma under this Section is deceased or incapacitated, a family member may  
21 apply for and receive the diploma on the person's behalf.

22 (e) The Guam Public School System and the Office shall jointly award  
23 the honorary high school diplomas as part of a high school graduation  
24 ceremony or as a separate ceremony to be held on or around Veterans Day."
