**AN ACT TO *AMEND* ITEM 2 OF SUBSECTION (c) OF
§15704.2, TITLE 22 G.C.A., AND TO AMEND TITLE 22
G.C.A. §18105, CHAPTER 18, RELATIVE TO HEALTH
MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATIONS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Licensing of Agents.** Item 2 of Subsection (c) of §15704.2 of
3 Article 7 of Chapter 15, Division 2 of Title 22 Guam Code Annotated is *amended* to
4 read:

1 “(2) accident and health, health maintenance organization or sickness-
2 insurance coverage for sickness, bodily injury or accidental death, and may
3 include benefits for disability income;”

4 **Section 2. Classes of Insurance.** §18105 of Article 1, Division 2 of Chapter
5 18 of Title 22 Guam Code Annotated is *amended* to read:

6 **“§18105. Accident, Sickness, Health, Health Maintenance**
7 **Organization, Property Damage and Liability Insurance.**

8 (a) Accident insurance and sickness or health insurance includes
9 insurance against injury, disablement resulting from sickness, and every
10 insurance appertaining thereto. Property damage insurance includes all types of
11 insurance against loss or damage to property and liability therefore. Liability
12 insurance includes all insurance against loss or damage resulting from accident
13 to, or injury, fatal or non-fatal, suffered by any person, and for which the
14 insurer is liable.

15 (b) A Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) is an insurer that is
16 licensed to engage in the business of insurance on Guam that provides
17 individual or group health care plans; or health care services which an enrolled
18 population might reasonably require to maintain good health, including, as a
19 minimum, emergency care, inpatient hospital and medical services, and
20 outpatient medical services on a prepaid basis and regulated under Guam law
21 for solvency. An HMO operating in such manner shall be issued by the
22 Commissioner a Health Maintenance Organization Certificate of Authority.”
