



**AN ACT TO APPROVE THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT
III TO THE CUSTOMER SERVICE AGREEMENT (CSA)
BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM AND THE
UNITED STATES NAVY WHICH AUTHORIZES THE
TRANSFER OF ADDITIONAL LAND AND POWER
FACILITIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that, pursuant to the provisions of Section 4 of Public Law 21-112, any changes
4 to the Customer Service Agreement between the Guam Power Authority (GPA)

1 and the U.S. Navy require approval by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Public
2 Utilities Commission. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the U.S. Navy
3 and GPA have agreed to amend the Customer Service Agreement pursuant to
4 Section 15.1 of the Customer Service Agreement:

5 ‘Whereas, Section 111 of Public Law 100-202 authorizes the Navy to
6 transfer to GPA, Navy-owned electric power generation,
7 transmission, and distribution facilities and equipment specified in
8 Table 3 of the Agreement; and

9 Whereas, Article 9.7 of the Agreement allows GPA and the Navy to
10 transfer from time to time other Navy-owned electrical power
11 facilities the Navy considers excess to their needs and GPA agrees are
12 useful to its customers; and

13 Whereas, considering the present and future ability of GPA to operate
14 the Island Wide Power System, GPA desires to amend Table 4 to
15 include additional properties it desires that the United States convey
16 to GPA pursuant to the Agreement, and such action is deemed in the
17 best interest of both parties.’

18 **Section 2.** Table 4 of the Customer Service Agreement is *amended* by
19 *adding* the following Navy 13.8 kV distribution assets and additional real
20 property with improvements:

- 21 “14. Breaker and Feeder Line P27 at Agana;
- 22 15. Breaker and Feeder Line P30 at Agana;
- 23 16. Breaker P31 at Agana;
- 24 17. Breaker P46 at Harmon;
- 25 18. Breaker P111 at Harmon;

- 1 19. Breaker P112 at Harmon;
- 2 20. Feeder Line P-54 from pole number MC-143/PQ178 to Potts
- 3 Junction;
- 4 21. Agana Power Plant containing approximately six (6) acres of land;
- 5 22. An easement interest to a certain portion of property in the
- 6 Municipality of Santa Rita (formerly Agat) containing approximately
- 7 six and a half (6.50) acres of land stretching south and west from the
- 8 centerline of Route 2A as shown on the GPA Tenjo Vista 34.5 kV
- 9 Transmission Line Routing Plan.”

10 **Section 3.** Line 11 of Table 4 of the Customer Service Agreement is
11 modified to read:

12 “11. Feeder Line P-54 from pole MC-29 through MC143/PQ178 (any line
13 section not previously transferred).”

14 **Section 4.** All other provisions of the Customer Service Agreement shall
15 remain in force and effect except as modified by this Amendment.

16 **Section 5.** The Amendment described herein, having been mutually agreed
17 to by the Navy and GPA, is approved and will be in effect when approved by the
18 Public Utilities Commission.
