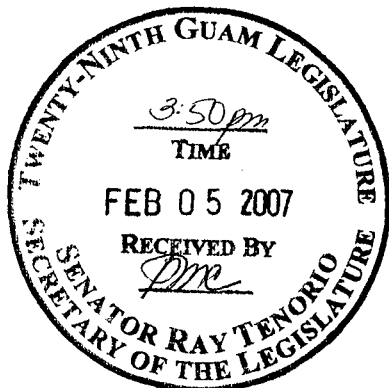





**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW §7119 TO CHAPTER 7 OF TITLE 17
OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED RELATIVE TO
ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR THE PURCHASE,
INSTALLATION, MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF AIR
CONDITIONING SYSTEMS AT GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL
SYSTEM FACILITIES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new §7119 is hereby *added* to Chapter 7 of Title 17 of the

3 Guam Code Annotated to read:

1 **“§7119. Standards for Air Conditioning Systems Funded Herein.**

2 Any air conditioning system purchased and used by the Guam Public School
3 System shall:

4 (a) Meet the comfort and air quality standards set forth for
5 Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) equipment
6 provided in Chapter 5 of the *Federal GSA’s Facilities Standards For*
7 *Public Buildings Service* (Revised November 2000 or later – PBS-
8 P100);

9 (b) Have repair and replacement parts readily available within
10 five (5) days, Saturdays, Sundays and Government of Guam holidays
11 excepted; and

12 (c) Be the subject of a warranty and maintenance agreement
13 that guarantees the system’s working life for not less than five (5)
14 years.”
