

the lieutenant governor of Guam. The director is still the director from the previous administration. If they do happen to be relative-



ly up-todate, ... they don't have a whole lot of information on them."

Bill 97, among other things, requires agencies to list directors, administrators and board members, post public notices related to the agency and list the agency's current and proposed budget.

Agencies also would be required to list all of their fees and contracts and include links to official documents they created or that have been written about them.

Any forms the public might need in order to get services from the agency also must be available for printing online, Forbes said.

"What we're wanting to do here is increase the accountability of departments and agencies by having that information easily available. A really important thing as well is we want the services that are provided by agencies and departments a little more accessible to the public," Forbes said. "If the public can access this via the Worldwide Web, it can result in more expeditious and better service to the people and cut down on expenses for the public."


