All fees collected under the Department of Agriculture's Fee Schedule for agricultural quarantine activities shall be deposited into said Fund. Deposits into the Fund shall include, but are not limited to, (i) import permit fees, (ii) export certificate fees, (iii) inspection fees and (iv) fees for commodity treatment services.
- (b) The Plant Protection and Quarantine Revolving Fund shall be used exclusively for agricultural quarantine purposes, including, but not limited to, the purchasing of necessary capital equipment or uniforms for Plant Protection and Quarantine Officers, a uniform allowance procedure for which is hereby expressly authorized. The certifying officer for the Fund shall be the Director of the Department of Agriculture.




