ARTICLE 1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Current through P.L. 27-104 (2004)

§ 60113. Plant Protection and Quarantine Revolving Fund Established.

a) There is hereby established a fund to be known as the Plant Protection and Quarantine Revolving Fund which shall be maintained separate and apart from any other funds of the government of Guam, and independent records and accounts shall be maintained in connection therewith. All fees collected under the Department of Agriculture's Fee Schedule for agricultural quarantine activities shall be deposited into said Fund. Deposits into the Fund shall include, but are not limited to, (i) import permit fees, (ii) export certificate fees, (iii) inspection fees and (iv) fees for commodity treatment services.

(b) The Plant Protection and Quarantine Revolving Fund shall be used exclusively for agricultural quarantine purposes, including, but not limited to, the purchasing of necessary capital equipment or uniforms for Plant Protection and Quarantine Officers, a uniform allowance procedure for which is hereby expressly authorized. The certifying officer for the Fund shall be the Director of the Department of Agriculture.

Pursuant to 2 GCA §9102, I respectfully request BBMR to prepare fiscal notes for the following measures:

Bill No. 4 (LS) – “An Act To Appropriate The Sum Of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) From The Education Facilities Fund To The Department Of Education For The Repair Of Air Conditioning In Public School Facilities.”

Bill No. 8 (LS) – “An Act To Amend To §58104 Of Title 12, Guam Code Annotated Relative To Adding Investment Banking And Securities And Commodities Trading To The List Of Eligible Activities For Qualifying Certificates.”

Bill No. 11 (LS) – “An Act To Add A New Item (28) & (29) To Item (K) Of §26203 Of Title 11, Guam Code Annotated Relative To Exempting The Wholesale Of Telecommunication Services And Off-Island Sales From Gross Receipts Taxes.”

Bill No. 12 (LS) – “An Act To De-appropriate \$135,360 From The Sums Appropriated To The Legislature And To Reappropriate Said Sum To The Public School Library Resources Fund.”

Bill No. 13 (LS) – “An Act To Enact A New 11 GCA Ch.43 To Create Tax Rebates For Educator Expenses And Enact The Educator Appreciation Act Of 2005.”

Bill No. 19 (LS) – “An Act To Add New Item (36), Subsection K, Section 26203, Article 2, Chapter 26, Division 2, Title 11, Guam Code Annotated, For The Purpose Of Exempting The Application Of The Gross Receipt Tax From The Sale Of Medicine, Medical Supply And Medical Equipment.”

Bill No. 21 (LS) – “An Act To Reprogram The Balance Of The Territorial Highway Fund And The Guam Construction Fund For The Purpose Of Funding Various Capital Improvement Projects.”

Bill No. 22 (EC) – “An Act To Add To A New Item (5) To Subsection 26202 Of Article 2, Chapter 26, Division 2, 11 GCA And A New Subsection (I) To Section 28106 Of Article 2, Chapter 28, 11 GCA, For The Purpose Of Exempting The Sale Of Medicine, Pharmaceuticals, Medical Equipment And Medical Supply, As Well As The Provision Of Medical Services From The Application Of The Gross Receipts Tax And To Remove The Application Of The Use Tax From The Importation Of Medical Equipment.”

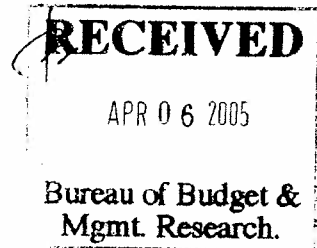

Pursuant to 2 GCA §9102, I respectfully request BBMR to prepare fiscal notes for the following measures:

- **Bill No. 95 (EC)**: An Act To Authorize The Director Of The Department Of Revenue And Taxation To Hire An Attorney To Represent The Department In Litigation Concerning The Affairs Of The Department And To appropriate The Sum Of One Hundred Thousand Dollars For Such Purpose.
- **Bill No. 100 (EC)**: An Act To Reassign Rulemaking Authority, And Contracting Authority And To Require An Economic Impact Assessment For Advance Disposal Fees By Amending Title 10, G.C.A. Sections 51505 And 51507.

- **Bill No. 112 (EC)**: An Act To appropriate The Sum Of \$77,937 From The Department Of Agriculture's Plant Protection And Quarantine Revolving Fund To The Department Of Agriculture's Guam Plant Inspection And Permit Fund For The Purpose Of Carrying Out The Provisions Of Sections 22 And 23 Of Chapter V Of Public Law 27-29.
