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

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that cottage industry activities are not currently allowed on Chamorro Land
- 4 Trust residential lots leased by residential leaseholders. Many "self-
- 5 employed" residential lot recipients have the capability and knowledge to

1	conduct cottage industry activities from their homes, but are not currently
2	authorized to do so. Small business activities such as preparing and selling
3	food products, cultural arts and crafts, and other "cottage" industries are
4	prohibited and may result in the termination of residential leases. By virtue of
5	the passage of this Act, it is the intent of I Liheslaturan Guåhan to provide
6	specific authorization for cottage industry activities on Chamorro Land Trust
7	residential lots to be conducted by Chamorro Land Trust residential
8	leaseholders through adding a new Section to Chapter 75 of Title 21 of the

10	Section 2. A new Section 75108.50 is hereby added to Chapter 75,

25	6) Dress Making.

1 Growing & Selling Plants and Flowers. 7) 2 8) Repair of Personal Effects. 3 (b) The Chamorro Land Trust Commission shall, pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Act, promulgate rules and regulations 4 governing cottage industry activities. These rules and regulations shall 5 6 include environmental considerations to protect the quality of life for 7 surrounding residents.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

finds that cottage industry activities are not currently allowed on Chamorro Land Trust residential lots by residential leaseholders. Many "self-employed" residential lot recipients have the capability and knowledge to conduct cottage industry activities from their homes but are not currently authorized to do so. Small business activities such as preparing and selling food products, cultural arts and crafts, and other "cottage" industries are prohibited and may result in the termination of residential leases. By virtue of the passage of this Act, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan* to provide specific authorization for cottage industry activities on Chamorro Land Trust residential lots to be conducted by Chamorro Land Trust

residential leaseholders through adding a new section to Chapter 75 of Title 21 of the Guam Code Annotated.

Section 2. A new Section 75108.50 is added to Chapter 75, Division 2, of Title 21 of the Guam Code Annotated as follows:

§75108.50. Cottage Industry Activity Authorized. (a) Within the laws of Guam, and subject to rules and regulations promulgated by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission, residential lease holders are authorized to conduct small scale cottage industry activities in which goods and services are produced primarily within their leased residential lots in which the total net income earned on those lots does not exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) per annum. For the purposes of this section, the following cottage industry activities are authorized:

- 1). Farm Produce & Light Agriculture
- 2). Baking & Producing Foodstuff
- 3). Arts & Crafts
- 4). <u>Cultural Practitioning</u>
- 5). Alternative Medicine (Suruhanu/Suruhana)
- 6). <u>Dress Making</u>
- 7). Growing & Selling Plants and Flowers
- 8). Repair of Personal Effects
- (b) The Chamorro Land Trust Commission shall, pursuant to the Administrative

 Adjudication Act, promulgate rules and regulations governing cottage industry activities.

These rules and regulations shall include any environmental considerations, which shall protect the quality of life for surrounding residents.

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on General and Omnibus Matters held a public hearing on the following at 9:00 a.m. on April 28, 2005 in the Legislative Session Hall, I Liheslaturan Guahan:

Bill 119 (EC) – AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SECTION 75108.50 TO CHAPTER 75, DIVISION 2, OF TITLE 21 OF THE GUAM CODE ANNOTATED TO ALLOW COTTAGE INDUSTRY ACTIVITIES ON RESIDENTIAL LEASED LAND BY CHAMORRO LAND TRUST RESIDENTIAL LEASEHOLDERS – introduced by Senator Benjamin J.F. Cruz.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY

Individuals that appeared before the Committee to present oral and written testin. It is on the bill were as follows:

Mr. Rufo J. Lujan, Chairman, Organization of People for Indigenous Rights, provided oral testimony in support of Bill 119 and made note that the bill safeguards the laws of Guam for which those individuals authorized to perform cottage industry activities must abide.

Mr. Robert Wolford, private citizen, provided oral testimony in support of Bill 119 and informed the Committee that passage of the bill would enhance his abilities to sale produce he has farmed.

Mr. Joe Garrido, private citizen, provided oral testimony in support of Bill 119 but informed the Committee that more discussion should occur relative to the definition of "Cottage Industry" to specify the types of activities that will actually be allowed and to prevent any loopholes, which would allow unintended commercial activities.

Mr. Greg Shocker, a private citizen and farmer, provided oral testimony in support of Bill 119. He asked that the committee consider commercial leaseholds and be more specific about what could or could not be done in the cottage industries.

Ms. Elizabeth Camacho, a private citizen, provided written testimony in support of Bill 119.

III. FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATION

The Committee on General and Omnibus Matters finds that the intent of Bill 119, as introduced by its author Senator Benjamin J.F. Cruz, would authorize Chamorro Land Trust Residential Lot Recipients to conduct cottage industry activities on the property within the laws of Guam. The current restriction on the use of the residential lots has created a precarious situation for residential lot holders who are self-employed as artisans, craftsmen, cultural practitioners, and sellers of Chamorro food. These residents do not have expressed authorization to conduct such activities and are therefore in technical violation of the leases issued to them by the Chamorro Land Trust Commission.

Based on concerns raised at the Public Hearing, the Committee has amended Bill 119 to include a definition of Cottage Industry as applicable to the legislation. The Committee finds that the intent of Bill 119 is complimentary to the Chamorro Land Trust Act.

I am writing to ask for your support on Bill No. 119 an act to add a new section 75108.50 to Chapter 75, Division 2, of Title 21 of the Guam Code Annotated to allow cottage industry activities on residential leased land by Chamorro Land Trust (CLT) residential leaseholders. I strongly believe that Bill No. 119 will have a positive impact on our Chamorro people who are (CLT) leaseholders who are employed or want to run their business fulltime and especially the ones who are unemployed but have found ways and means to survive by planting crops, using their talents such as: wood carving, cooking, nursery/plants etc...; but are unable to sell on Chamorro Land Trust Property, for it is not allowed because we fall under the Cottage Industry Business. Without the passage of Bill No. 119 It only makes it harder for (CLT) leaseholders to make financial ends meet, especially when we have to go elsewhere to sell or try to sell our products that retailers want less money for what the product is worth which doesn't even include labor but, we have to sell at their cost just to put food on our table. Taking into account the price of gas keeps increasing and considering the fact that some don't even have transportation but; have to rely on other people which at times could be a burden on oneself. Mr. Speaker I asked that you take to your heart a great consideration on what we (CLT) leaseholders need to do just to survive in today's high economy.

CRIME: I also strongly believe that crime in the community will diminish by having stay-at-home moms, dads and/or families who are (CLT) leaseholders who could operate and run their businesses from home. Another vital issue that presently affects our children is that they have less parental supervision because parents or single parents either have to work one or two jobs. I believe that if Bill 119 becomes law our children and the safety of them will be attended too, when they come home from school, discipline will play a vital role in having our children learn and know the business. Mr. Speaker I urge and pray that you take into consideration my testimony and believe in Bill No. 119.
